A Little Help Here...

I have been told many times by my wife that I start conversations halfway through a thought. On first glance at a conversation in Mark 9, the distressed Father appears to be making no sense. However, I think he makes perfect sense because I have been there myself...



So they brought him. When the spirit saw Jesus, it immediately threw the boy into a convulsion. He fell to the ground and rolled around, foaming at the mouth. Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" "From childhood," he answered. "It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. But if you can do anything, take pity on us and help us." "If you can?" said Jesus. "Everything is

possible for him who believes." Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" (Mark 9:20-24)

Obviously, the Father had hope in Christ or he wouldn't have brought him there in the first place. What we see is a person who has given up on his own strength and power and is in a situation that seems hopeless. His statement is one of complete honesty. In a sense he is saying, "Jesus my hope is in you but, this struggle has brought me to my knees and my faith has taken a beating." He was asking Christ to strengthen his faith.

As crazy as it sounds, when we are at this point we are where we need to be. If we have turned over complete control, God can do amazing things. There is nothing better to help our unbelief, than seeing God at work. If you are there just turn it over, pray and watch God work.
