Dear Ladies,

I hope you all read Roland's report too so you know what has been happening with him. He said "His first laser treatment on the stone in his saliva gland felt like a jack hammer." He feels better now but has to go back for more in the next few months.

In Nov. I had to see the dentist and finally finished the 12th with him till Feb. 2013 I saw the physical therapist 8 times in Nov. and on the 26th Pamela McAdams came for a few days and was a big help with the internet work.

In Dec I saw the physical therapist six times. On Dec 10th Mike and Melissa arrived from Oregon and you can imagine our excitement after it being five years since they

were able to be in Paris. Mike preached in his Dad's place and I missed hearing them sing with us in worship. We celebrated with Rose Mary's family and them for the 24th and 25th of Dec. Everyone went down for the 31st prayer meeting but me, as I nearly had pneumonia. I had to see my doctor twice and was put on antibiotics for 13 days in all. I am much better now. I wasn't able to go with Roland, Mike, Melissa n Ida Patlow who arrived on Jan 2nd to Franc and Liva's for the Bible study in their home.

Since Ida has come I have learned to crochet and am enjoying that so much. I've learned the importance of a four ply yarn, four threads in one in the sturdiness of the yarn and your work. I made a small doily and gave it to one of our members as a gift and since then made one more of cotton. I'm using acrylic yarn of four ply and am making a lap warmer or can be folded to use as a shawl. I am thankful that Ida could help me learn. I have tried in the past but am now doing better.

We had the funeral of our beloved Nodia Milcent on Jan 2nd and the baptism of James Saint Louis at 7:30 P.M. Liliane Kitongo has lost her Dad in Zaire, Africa. She was able to be home and visit her family this past Summer and won't be able to go to the funeral. Pray for these families.

Roland has had an inflammation of the colon as a reaction to medication that the specialist gave him for the stone in the saliva gland. He is feeling much better now after seeing another specialist that gave him medicine to treat that. Thanks for all the prayers!

Roland has had some wonderful Bible studies with Veronica and Honoree. They have since started studying Eng/Bible with me on Wednesdays before our evening Bible study with two other friends.

Veronique is 37, Honoree is 26, Victorien is 30 and Yann is 28 years old. They all stay for Wednesday night Bible studies and we are happy for this.

Please pray that the Word of God will change their lives. We have been having ten on Wednesday nights lately. James is still always faithful.

I've been having about 7 in the Sunday morning 3-5 year old class and five in the evening class. We also had from Sweden Gabrielle Opoku and her children. They came up and ate with us so we got to know each other better.

God bless and keep you all. It was good to have family home and we will miss Ida when she leaves too.
