Hello everyone,

Thank God for the internet, it is a wonderful tool to spread the gospel thousands mile away from where you live and work. Last week I got a mail by a fellow name Steve Mutachi? He is originally from the democratic republic of Congo and lives a thousand miles from the capital city Kinshasa, in the town of Fugurume. In his very first mail he said I am a Christian but want to become a genuine disciple of Christ. With the help of a member of our congregation from the same country, I was able to put him in contact with the

church in his home town, where the church was started two weeks before Steve contacted me. He has made contact with them and started Bible study I won't be surprised that soon I will hear that he was immersed into Christ.

More good news, two more precious souls were added to the Lord's Kingdom here in Paris! In August I had the great joy of baptizing Clement Okopu 32 years old from Ghana, but presently living in Italy and trying to move to Paris. It was during his visits to Paris and services of the Church that he decided to be immersed into Christ for the remission of his sins so I was happy to study with him and immerse him into Christ.

The second one is Thomas Heyman, the French young man that I had been studying with; it was during his visit to his girlfriend from Madagascar who is a member of the church there that he decided to obey the gospel. He is back to Paris and comes regularly to service.

Sister Annett from the Philippines placed membership with us; she works for the embassy of her own country and will be with us for 6 years. Our sister Elisabeth Ikeme from Nigeria has lost her father in September and two weeks later, lost her oldest sister, she was not able to make it back to Nigeria for the funeral. Please pray for her and all the new babes in Christ.

Sad to say but Brother Stephen Adjekota as left us for a Pentecostal group. As long we were able to help him in various ways he was present, but once we ceased to help him he did not show up for the last 3 months.

In regard to the number brochures that were taken from church in August was 476 and in September 401. I put out 12 new brochures so right now we have a total of 207 different kinds of brochures available.

In regard to the website in August 11,341 people visited the website from 64 countries and in September 9,758 from 67 countries.

In September we had the visit of Frederic and Daniela Bahloul from Strasbourg France. It was the first time for her to visit Paris they stayed 4 days with us. Frederic is Arabic and his wife from Romania. For the past 3 Sundays we have a couple from Colombia, They are nice and come with their Bible and try to follow the Bible class and sermon, I tried to talk with them but it's difficult because they only know a few words in French and no English at all.

In November we are in charge of the November 11th retreat in Lille the theme is based on Romans 12.1-2 . The annual preacher

meeting will be November 29th till December 1st in Chateau Saint Albin and we are also in charge of the program and the theme is based on Genesis 17. We also are preparing for next year's second Bible bowl in Mauritius Island, which will be held from July 6th through the 25th and we will have Doctor Richard England from Freed Hardman University as guest speaker. The book for the Bible Bowl will be Acts of the Apostles the first 14 chapters. We will be doing door knocking, inviting people to the Gospel meeting and try to set up home Bible studies with people. So far 12 people from our congregation are planning on coming, if you are interested, we would love to have you with us. In Mauritius Island the people speak as first language English, second French and third Creole, so therefore there would be no language barrier and the island is really a beautiful island.

By December we will have lost \$1500 per month of our support, but we are confident that God will provide. I know that everywhere in the world the economy has been bad and that many churches are facing the effects of this bad economy. French unemployment is up to 12%, but everything is going up, food, transportation and everything else but with our socialists it just keep on increasing taxes like crazy , and our president has become the most unpopular president of the fifth Republic of France.

We love you all and thanking God for love and car that you provide to us trough out the years helping us spreading the Good news in France and in the French World.
