Dear ones in Christ and family.

Thank you to all of you who have been praying for my health. Here is the latest in regard to my saliva gland, I went to see the specialist and have been under treatment for two months November 27th I will go back to see what will be the next step to take, either remove my gland by surgery or something else, but he want to save my saliva gland at all cost. I am trusting the Lord that everything will go fine.

Since the first of the year, so far we have had 5 families that lives us and the last one is the Vixama family, Rosny and Veronique they been transferred for their job to Nice southern France. But the

Lord as blessed us with two families we have two that have placed membership with us, a young couple Sterling and Alex Coleman, he is American but she is Chinese, he is here for studies, after spending few days in a hotel and finding out that in Paris everything was very expensive we invited them to stay with us, until they find a place for rent, since they know nothing about France I help them as much as I could to get an apartment, Glad they have one now. The other person is Irena Ivanova a lawyer from Bulgaria, who was recently converted in Strasbourg France, she is in Paris for two month and hoping to get a full time job and stay longer. Brother Fred Aklamanu from Ghana recently arrived and is here for his studies and the first thing he did when he arrived was to put himself in contact with the Church, so we are happy to have him with us for the 2 to 3 years to come.

Edwige Maussang a friend of sister Margarita she has been coming for a few months I have study the Bible with her and she took a Bible correspondence course and completed with success, she knows what to do to obey the gospel and be in Christ, when I last talked to her she replied give me a month and will make a decision. I am praying that she will make the right decision for her life. We had the privilege to have Brother Stiven Mendez from Caen 3 ½ hours away from PARIS to spend a weekend with us so he could be at worship Sunday, he was really happy and pray that he will be able to do it again soon. I send him regularly material so he can grow spiritually.

I am presently finishing up my Sunday morning adult class on comparative religion, and once I finish, Brother Peter a brilliant and sound in faith Christian, will take over my class, I am looking forward to hear him teaching that class. On Wednesday evening I am continuing my class on survey of the New Testament.

Colette Chao friend from work at school, Marie Laurence, a French teacher wanted to come with her to visit the Church. When she came she was so pleased that since then she has been coming regularly. when I met her, she told me that she tried to read the Bible by herself and find out that it was not easy to understand , so I started to answer the question she had in her mind so now she is taking a Bible correspondence course with me but also one to one Bible studies, I asked her if she had a Bible of her own and replied no, so I gave her one and she say how much do I how you for it, and I reply to her it's on the house , she was so pleased and surprised , than the

following Sunday she told that anyone that would like help with their schooling she would be glad to help during the school vacations free of charge. So 8 of them signed up.

In the last couple months 945 brochures were taken from the racks. Presently we have a choice of 230 different brochures. In regard to the website in September 5776 people have visited the website and two people have requested bible correspondence course, one from southern France and one from Indonesia. In October 6039 people have visited the website from 71 countries.

We consider blessed and privileged to be able to continue to spread the gospel in the French world. And we are grateful to God and to all of you that are able to make possible for us to continue to work in the Lord's kingdom. Until next time may God continue to richly bless you all.
