

CAMEROON REPORT OF MARCH 2015 BY ABASIAMA



THANK YOU once again for your precious time and the commitment you have invested in the work of West African Missions. It is always a great privilege for me to relate to you the progress and prospects of the soul-winning work of gospel preaching in Cameroon. The year 2015 has already kicked off with great results trailing our gospel campaign. These encouraging results include but not limited to the statistics of converted souls. We are further encouraged by the steady growth of the local congregation in Limbe, the Washing Point assembly which serves as our missionary base of evangelistic operations. The church at Washing Point is in a rapid



state of growth. For instance, the celebration that characterizes the addition of the newly converted is almost becoming as regular as the celebration of the Lord's Supper. In the month in focus, we preached to many but as usual only the obedient few are eligible to feature in

this report as the most recent converts to Christianity. Among these new believers is Brother David Okon whose immersion photos are attached below. Brother David became converted to Christ not as a result of our effervescent radio preaching campaign, but through my personal contact with him. He is a

teachable young man who desires to know the Lord. By God's grace, I believe we will successfully nurture and mentor him to maturity in Christ.

In addition to the youthful David, I have baptized three other souls in this April. They include Clevis, Samuel, and Valerie. Technically, these converts are the results of March efforts. Chronologically they belong to April records. Whatever the case may be, my greatest concern is how to help them in their struggle to remain in the faith. They came to the church through our radio preaching. The radio preaching has consumed a lot of resources but the program is worth the consumption because many souls have come to know Christ through it. The value of the money spent in maintaining the radio evangelism cannot be compared with the value of the souls that have been saved. For that reason, we will continue to spend our resources in sustaining this campaign. Also, our building project is financially draining. However, the necessity of such an infrastructure is the motivating factor that keeps us focused on bringing the project to completion. All these works are very demanding but we have no better option than to face these challenges head-on, with the belief that somehow, our congregational goal will be achieved. And when this happens, everyone who's helping hands have been our support will not be

forgotten. We will always be grateful to you, our sponsors and donors for always being there for us and with us. We thank you for your support which has provided for us the financial aspects of the work. From all us, my family, the orphans, and the church, we say thank you and God bless you.
