REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2015 (TOM EKPOT JR)

My very dear brethren, I greet you all in the precious name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ, whose death on the cross brought those of us who were far near. We will ever remain grateful to Him for his work of generosity. On behalf of my wife Sandra and my children Goodnews and Godswill, I say thank you to you for remembering us in your prayers. We have no idea what would have happened to us if you were not constantly praying for us. I believe God that you are doing well physically and even spiritually. May His grace that saw us through last month see us through this month as well. Our new government has spent one month in the office, yet bombing is on the increase. But we trust that God will allow only what will advance the Gospel come our way. I thank our almighty God for helping me out of the clutch of malaria and typhoid diseases. I was down with malaria and typhoid, but the prayer of the saints was effectual. One frightening thing about these twin sickness is that their treatment is weakening.

Brethren, the first half of the year is gone. It is time therefore to look back and see how far we have performed to

help us prepare for tomorrow. I know that I have taught 62 Bible classes in three different congregations. I have preached not less than 12 sermons in different congregations. I have set up several independent Bible studies, which are on-going. In the next 3 months, by the grace of God I am set to teach 29 Bible classes. Brethren, I know that I am not doing enough compared to the grace and opportunities God has given me. Pray that God will open more doors for me to extend His word to people who need salvation.

Within the month of June, I was able to teach 12 Bible classes in 3 different congregations (Foron Mission and Old Foron congregations on Sunday, Ring Road Church of Christ on Tuesday, and Mazah on Friday). Our weekend outing at Mazah continues. I know that the Devil has a grip on people's mind and will-power, hence it become difficult to snatch them out of the wicked one's hand. However, we will not relent in sounding the message out and ensuring that the saved are kept saved.

My family is doing just well even though my children come down with health issues. We face daily challenges common to life in Nigeria, so they are not strange things to us. But one interesting thing is that we face those challenges with hope for better condition beyond here. We thank God for solving the persistent fuel crisis that rocked the nation the last two weeks of May and the first two weeks of June. The price of gas had risen beyond what we could afford. But God kept His promises of providence. We have no idea what will happen under this regime. We only pray God to give us opportunity to meet and worship Him peacefully. Dearly beloved, we say thank you to all of you for making this great sacrifice to support the work in Africa. May God almighty continue to visit you all and bless you and your house hold. Permit me beg for prayers for my mother who is presently very sick. She has been on sick bed for days now. I know that age plays a factor, but nothing is above God's power. As it please Him, may He do to

His glory. Once again, on behalf of my family, I say thank you all.
