

Verbally Inspired

The Bible claims that it is verbally inspired (2 Timothy 3:16). The Greek word translated "inspired" is theopneustos from (Theos, "God," pneo, "to breathe"). This means that the very words of the Bible narrative

are from God. In 2 Samuel 23:2, David declared: "The Spirit of Jehovah spake by me, And his word was upon my tongue."

Here David affirms: (a) He has been used as a instrument of the Spirit; (b) The ultimate source of the message was God; (c) The divine message was presented by words. Though David's tongue was used, in reality, the word was God's. In Acts 1:16, Peter states that the Holy Spirit spoke through the mouth of David concerning Judas' betrayal of Jesus (Psalm 41:9)

We are told in 2 Peter 1:21 that various men, chosen by God to be the human instruments to reveal

His will through the written word, wrote as they were guided by the Holy Spirit. They did not write what they “thought” God said. These men did not pen what they “wished” God said; neither did they write what they “thought” God “ought” to have said. They wrote **exactly what God wanted them to write.**

Because the Bible is verbally inspired of God, it is the powerful medium (Romans 1:16; Hebrews 4:12) through which mankind is to be convicted of their sins (Acts 2:37) and converted to Christ and His church (Acts 2:41,47). Let us as faithful brethren continue to preach and teach God’s inspired and powerful word to the spiritually lost (2 Timothy 4:2; Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16)

“Why Heaven Holds All To Me!”

1, Heaven holds all to me because I long to see God face to face and in heaven such will be possible (Rev. 21:22-27).

2. Heaven holds all to me because I long for a place where tears, pain, crying, sorrow, and death are no more (Rev. 21:4).



3. Heaven holds all to me because Jesus prepared it (John 14:1-3).

4. Heaven holds all to me because I long for a place

where sin doesn’t dwell. A place where cowards, unbelievers, liars, fornicators, sorcerers, and idolaters will not be found (Rev. 21:8).

5. Heaven holds all to me because there I can sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and all the saints of all time (Mt. 8:11).

6. Heaven holds all to me because once there I can worship God around his throne forever and ever (Rev. 4:11).

7. Heaven holds all to me because at the end of life’s way I will have spent the best years of my life in preparation for it (Mt. 10:22; 2 Timothy 4:6-8).

8. Heaven holds all to me because it reminds me that faithfulness will not go unrewarded (Rev. 2:10), motivating me to press on (Phil. 3:14).
