It is a great privilege once again for me to welcome all of you to Cameroon missions. As always, it is important for me to start by thanking God for all His goodness and blessings upon us in His service. It sure is necessary for me to feel this way because I have come to realize the necessity of spreading the gospel of Christ wherever man is found. Cameroon is boasting of about twenty million people in terms of population. Out of this mammoth crowd a very relatively small number of people are members of the Church of Christ. Our preaching work in Cameroon is a very strong and powerful mission that has always recorded huge success in soul winning and congregational edification. The month of January came and met us actively campaigning for Christ in Limbe and beyond. Cameroon Christians are highly blessed to have such evangelistic machinery which we call West African Missions Our duty to keep the saved exhorted as we see the Day approaching and to bring more souls into the fold. To this end, we made a united effort in the first month of 2015. Thanks be to God who always thinks well of the workers in His congregation.

The congregation at Washing Point is doing great things in the Lord. We are the leading congregation in Cameroon when it concerns taking the gospel to various places within the country through mass media proclamation of the uncompromising gospel truth. The Church of Christ in Limbe is literally rescuing many from eternal death by showing them the way to heaven. It is a war front and the good fight is unrelentingly being fought. We are living in hope that victory will continue to be on our side and more souls will come to Christ. Please continue to pray for us as we join hands to lift up the banner of truth in a world that tilts toward the lies of the enemy. Pray for

us because the country of Cameroon is now seriously affected by the Boko Haram agenda. This insurgency is especially in the northern part of the country where one of our brothers almost was killed while fighting for Cameroon. His name is Yari Emmanuel who is about two years in the faith. Pray for us because we are always praying for you and thanking God for your partnership with us in the work of the great commission.

We always tell you how your support has made a big difference in the life of the congregations in Cameroon. It is not just the Washing Point church that is blessed by your financial assistance. The impact of your support is felt across the nation as the work we do is touching lives everywhere in Cameroon. My family is blessed by it. Love for the orphans is demonstrated by it.
