The year came in swiftly and left swiftly. It seems to me that the month went faster than usual. Interestingly, we are gradually moving towards the end of the year. It is time we re-access our performance and see possible areas we need to improve to meet our target. Thank you all for your individual and collective prayers. God is working through you to ensure that the Church of Christ is not only alive, but is expanding to bring the lost to salvation. Thank you for your prayers for my sister. My senior sister developed tumor on her vertebral column. The doctor ordered for immediate surgery before it developed into cancer. We were still gathering the money as all the amount needed

was not available. Meanwhile, she was taking the drugs that were administered to her. Prayers were said everywhere on her behalf. Brethren, today she does not need the surgery again. The tumor has disappeared. God has done it again. Please, join us in appreciating our Redeemer for His mercies endure forever.

Our Lord has continued to be good to us, despite our failings in some areas. I do believe that I am not doing enough to help in spreading the gospel. I pray God should help me to be like Apostle Paul, that where ever I enter, God's name must be mentioned, the gospel must be preached, and people must be reconciled to God. July was a busy month anywhere. I travelled to attend the funeral of my friend's wife, a woman who stood with her husband to preach the Gospel even when times were most difficult. returns to her village at the end of the school term. We have the duty of grooming her in Christ.

My weekly classes at Mazah Road are ongoing. We are studying the book of 1 Corinthians on Fridays and Sandra takes the women class on Saturday. They are studying the women of the Bible. We are hoping that teachers will be

developed among them. Already, we have two men who handle their Sunday classes. Keep praying for them. The economic situation in the country is affecting everybody, and is affecting every facet of human existence. Please, do keep praying for us because the economic hardship has increased the number of armed robbers in the nation. Already we are facing Islamic militant, the increase in armed robbers will complicate things in the country. Pray for my students who are returning to campus from August 8th. Pray that they will have a peaceful semester, pray that they will be able to go through the semester despite the challenging economy. From the August 2 through 5 I was in Gombe State speak to congregations each night. I will give you the detail of the program that led to the conversion of young Muslim boy Muhammed. Brethren, it would not have been possible if not that you presented yourselves as instrument of use. May God keep on blessing you all in every good way. On behalf of my family, I say thank you to you all for standing by us. I wish you happy month of August.
