Dear beloved family in Christ,

It is our prayers that the holiday season went well for you and we would like to wish to all of you a blessed new year in the lord. December was a traveling season for several of our members.

Sister Enyo went home (Togo Africa) to be with her family for the holiday season's and will not return to France until April or May 2016. we are very happy that she was able to make her trip.

Brother Steven Mendez went to Columbia south America with all of his family, he not been back there for 12 years, and he was looking forward to visit his family but especially his aunt for which

he praying that she would obey the gospel, and she did, that was the highlight of his trip, beside seeing the rest of his family.

Brother Tremont Drephis made a 3 week trip back to Haiti to take care family matters.

Brother Godefroy Kitondo and his family went to England following the death of someone in his family.

Sister Betty Dupros went to Guadeloupe following the death of her stepfather. Prior to her trip I took her to a medical center outside of Paris to be fitted with her new prosthesis for her foot.

While workers where installing bathroom for handicap people I had the opportunity to study with a young Muslim man from Algeria by the Rabba, at first he had lot of questions about who we were actually, but even more surprised when I told him that I used to be a Muslim of course this opened up to more questions, but finally he admitted to me that he was really interested in religion period, but claimed to be Muslim even if he did not really believe in it.

December 31 first 122 of us and visitor had our new year's party and he really went well. Food fun fellowship and prayers. January 12th Rose and I flew to the states for our first grandson wedding, first he was not supposed to get married until the summer, but changed their date to January. He wanted his grandfather to perform the ceremony, which I was glad to do it. Good thing we had enough flying mileage to make our 2 week trip. For little while we though that we would not be able to fly back to Paris because the snow storm that hit the northwest , in fact we were stranded for two days in our daughter house . But finally we were able to make it back to Paris fine.

January 17th we had our first baptism for 2016 Joy Voltaire (17) the son of Louisidor and Oriana Voltaire, we are very happy for them.

My Bible study with Jordy Wisgath are going well and I believed he will soon obey, and I have started another study with Rubenson Ceus (gong on 19th year old) he has many , many good questions about the Bible and we have been having Bible study 3 times a week.

Our Sunday night English worship attendance has been way down since the bombing and terrorist attack in Paris. It is our

prayers that it will grow back with time and more stability in the land.

540 Bible tracts were taken in the last two months and in regard to the websites in December 5406 people visited the website from 68 countries and in January 2016, 5017 visitor from 68 countries. We want to express of deep gratitude for all of you that are praying for our safety and are continuing to support us spiritually and financially. May God continue to richly bless you with good spiritual and physical health as you continue to serve Him in 2016.
