## February 2016 Report From Cameroon by Abasiam



The month of February 2016 was a tough time for us as a church in



Cameroon. The challenges came in battalions, and so were the blessings. We grappled with the passing of brother Yari, the youngest captain in the Cameroon's army who died at the hand of the so-called Boko Haram. Although we are still to completely come to terms with the harsh reality that Brother Emmanuel is no more with us on this earth, we are however comforted by the knowledge that blessed are the dead who die in Christ. The passing of this hero at the age of 31 has saddened a great number of people. At his funeral conducted by the government, the Church of Christ was granted the opportunity to



conduct a service during which I delivered a message from the gospel of Christ to hearing of many civilian and military dignitaries. The governor of the Southwest Region, Mr. Okalia Bilai Bernard was also able to hear the gospel, perhaps for the

first time.

Our radio preaching program was interrupted for a while because we could not pay for the airtime. We have been struggling to maintain this program for more than five years now. God has been gracious to us in this regard, and by His strength we have been able to preach on Eden Radio all these years. The results of the radio campaign for Christ have proven to be worth the stress. Many souls have found their way to the Christ. You may recall that a couple of months ago we brought you a report of how a member of the Jehovah's Witnesses came to the church of Christ and got baptized after a while. He was brought to the Washing Point Church of Christ as a result of listening to LET THE BIBLE SPEAK. His name is Edmond. This brother has been very punctual in attendance and faith in worship. Brother Edmond has been able to introduce his wife to the church of Christ, and she too has finally made up her mind to abandon the Jehovah's Witnesses to embrace the gospel truth with the Church of Christ. Another area of progress in our ministry is our building project.
