REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2016 (TOM EKPOT JR.)

Beloved brethren in Christ, I greet you all in the precious name of our Saviour Jesus Christ, whose death has changed our focus and destination in this life and here after. I thank you all for standing up for Jesus, and your conviction about Christ continues to inspire the spread of His message across the globe. To God be glory in everything. The month of April has come and went so swiftly. We are grateful to God for allowing us experience his faithfulness throughout the month. I know that every blessing goes with responsibilities and attended challenges. God saw us through all. I was sick for a whole week. All drugs prescribed failed to grant desired healing. But God did it on His own, that at the end, I can shout hallelujah! May His healing power rest on those of us who are still down with one health issue or the other.

As I mentioned in my last month report concerning Foron Mission, the Children class is gaining attention. I have been able to secure material for teaching ages 2-6 years. I am still looking for materials for 7-10 years. However, the children are feeling excited

about the whole thing. In their entire life, they have never experienced Children Bible Study. Please, keep praying for them. See a cross section of some of the Children copying their homework from the chalk board. We are working to provide them with a more convenient place for seating and writing.



At Mazah, the Church is moving well. Sandra started ladies Bible class for them. The class is scheduled for Saturdays. They are happy about it. They are only 7 ladies in the congregation. Currently they are learning about the women of the Bible. I am grateful that Sandra has come in to help in this regards.

As I mentioned in my last month report, I went up the North East, part of the area devastated by Islamic terrorists. The roads are so bad because no construction company will accept to go there because of insurgency. A journey of 8 hours lasted for 12 hours. The whole area is in shamble. Homes are abandoned, several kids are left without parents, and several women have lost their husbands. I was there to conduct marriage seminar in Jalingo, in Taraba State. The program was a huge success as many preachers and church leaders and members attended the two day program. See a cross of the class while teaching.



Come this 7th of May, I will be leaving Jos again for 9 days evangelism campaign for Christ in Dutse Alhaji, a settlement in the Federal capital territory. I am going with 9 of my students. Keep us in

your prayers. Keep praying for Nigeria, because the Nation is facing the worst period of economic melt-down. Life is very difficult with the average people here. Crime has increase because several young people have no job.
