Social – for October will be Oct 30. Plans are for Bro Bob to be here. We are celebrating 31 years in Ellabell



UNITY

One of Aesop's fables is about a family of sons who were always quarreling. One day the father told his sons to bring him a bundle of sticks. He then gave each one

the entire bundle in succession and told each to break it. They tried but were unable.

Next he gave each one a single stick and told each to break it. They broke it easily.

He said, "If you are of one mind and unite you will be like this bundle. You are divided among yourselves and can be broken as easily as these sticks."

Unity is to characterize God's people. Jesus said that the faith of the world depends upon the unity of the disciples (Jn 17:21). Francis Schaeffer wrote, "Now that is frightening. Should we not feel some emotion at this point?" (*The Mark of the Christian*). Paul wrote that we are to make every effort to keep the unity that the Holy Spirit has set in the church (Eph 4:4). Notice that we did not manufacture this unity. We are to keep it. Scripture states that the Lord hates "one who spreads strife among brothers" (Prov 6:19).
