

REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2011 (TOM EK POT JR)

Dearly beloved,

I salute you all in Jesus name. Thank you for your prayers and support for the work of Christ throughout the year 2011. We all will agree that it was a year full of ups and down. The good thing is that in every bit of our existence, God never left us even in a split of a second. Without His grace I don't know what would have become of us. I tell you what, you stood with us in thick and thin to ensure that we are alright, and the message of Christ is proclaimed unhindered. May God bless you all.

The month of December came and is almost gone, left for the next few hours. We pray the God's grace which saw us at the beginning should be available for us throughout the remaining days and into the next year. On the 4th of December, I left for Agbo in Delta State to train preachers and teachers. I was a wonderful program. I left with one of the staff of the School of Biblical studies, Jos. We work 10 hours each day teaching four courses a day. For the two weeks we were there, I tell you I was encouraged as I saw men and women who desire to be equipped for the work of the ministry. Among the group were two men in their 70s who said, they want to learn who to teach

the Bible effectively so that the rest of their few days they have on earth will be utilized to the glory of the Lord. On the three Sundays, we were there, I spent two of the Sundays in Edo state, where two of the students came from. They wanted me to come down and teach and preach in their congregations. I thank God I had the opportunity to do that.

Join us to thank God for the two souls that were added to the Body of Christ at Toro congregation. This addition came two days after we lost one of the old women we have there. The sister who died was a great inspiration to the Church. Her burial offered us opportunity to preach. Two day later, two people decided for Jesus. At Mazah congregation, we also had a soul added to the body of Christ this week. Please, pray for these sisters so that the trouble of this life will not carry them away. Christians in Nigeria, especially in the northern Nigeria are under great threat each day. Each day we gather for worship, we can't say how it will end because of Muslim militants. Please, never forget us in your prayers. In one of the states called Yobe, over 90,000 have been displaced by the same Islamic militant groups. We pray for will of God to be done in our lives.

Let me use this opportunity to express our deep gratitude to you again for taking pains to pray for us, and to send your help to us. May God never forget the good work you are doing. May His infinite blessings remain with you all. I wish you all a wonderful 2012 ahead.
