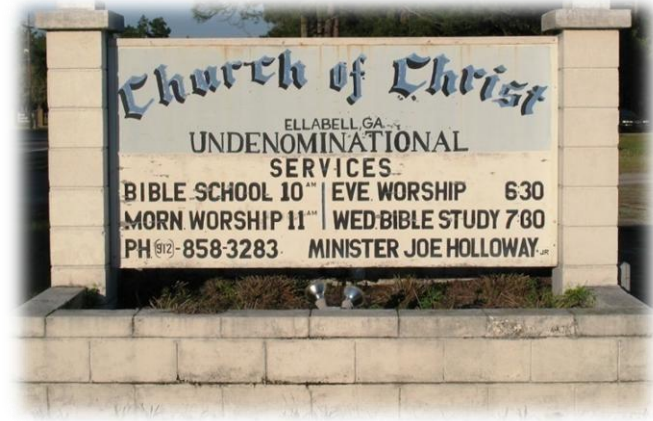

Email from Nigeria (rec'd last Sunday)

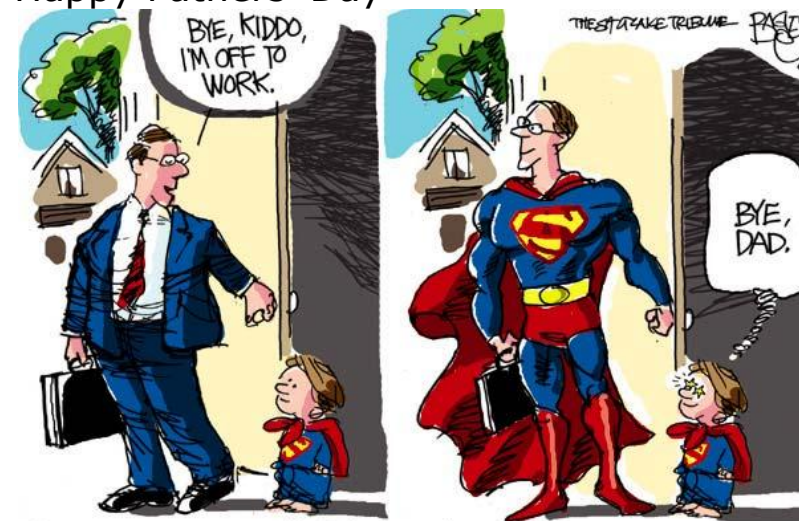
Hi brother Holloway,
