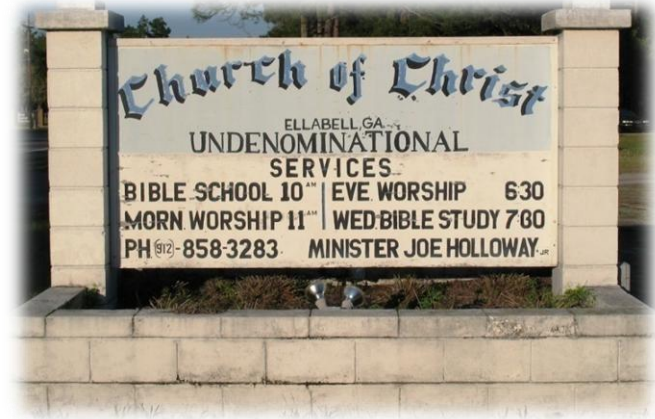

To my precious family in Christ and friends, greetings in the precious name of Jesus,

Sometimes it rains and sometimes the sun is shining wonderfully. Through the years of serving God, I have learned as I reflect back, that if we always trust in Him, everyday it's a sunshiny day. Of course sometimes in the middle of our struggles we don't seem to see the hands of God doing something, but believe me He is always with each and every one of us. (As Jesus promised in Matt 28:18-20.) He will always be with us. All we have to do is to stop and reflect back at what God has done for you in the past and continues to do so today for each one of us. So therefore let us continue to trust Him more each day, than on ourselves, and you will see what God can continue to do in our life.

Good news, Philippe Herzoc, the former pastor from the Reformed church, which I mentioned in my previous letter, that I had not heard from him for two months. Well he called me to wish me a Happy New Year and apologize for being silent for so long, but explained that he was in the process of moving back to Switzerland to be close to his family and also to get a secular job, because he could no longer be a pastor where he could not teach the truth. In regards to his and his wife Rosa's baptism for the remission of their sins, they have not changed their mind but will do it in the Lord's Church in Geneva, Switzerland. I contacted the Church in Geneva and told them the good news.

After two and a half months of hard work, I have finally finished the twelve PowerPoint lessons, called "What the Bible Says" and if you go on our website (The French section) you will be able to see the first four lessons. Brother Alain Herrou is doing the recording for me. I also finished the presentation called "History of the Church" Both the French and English versions are on the website. From the 8th till the 12th of January we went to Strasbourg for three reasons. First of all to bring material for the Church, to have my car fixed and to visit Daniel and Tammy Frérot family and Tammy's Mother Gail, and while there I helped Daniel with the meeting place of the church, arranging things and bringing equipment and went shopping with him for more material. While there, Daniel and I were invited by his Turkish neighbor to a pizza shop, since Daniel had told him that I was a former Muslim he wanted to talk to me, even though he does not practice Muslim religion, and our discussion went well and I encouraged to continue to talk and to study the Bible with Daniel and if he needed too he could call or write to me.

We visited with Frederic Bahloul who is presently working in Strasbourg and helping Daniel Frérot with the Church, after graduating from Sunset international Bible school last year. If there is one thing that France needs is more workers in the field.

Upon our return from Strasbourg Pamela Mac Adams came to be with us, but also to go to the ladies retreat in France with Rose. I must say that every time that she came to Paris she always willing to help with the work! This time she re-did our website, because our previous one was not working properly. In fact for the last couple months we had more than 3000 visitors from 59 nations.

Garret Turner from the States who is presently studying in Europe came and visited us for a few days; we know Him and his

family who were former members of the Mechanicsville Church in Virginia. I even had him preach for us one Sunday night.

We were so happy for the visit of Paul and Edie Tews from Houston, Texas, who were former members of our congregation until a year in half ago. We were very happy to see them again and wish they were still here with us.

Since Franck and Liva Delormel moved 87 kilometers south of Paris, we don't see them very often at Church, so Rose and I and Sister Denise went to visit them, and we ate together and afterward had a Bible study with them.

With the cold spell we recently had, it cracked our old chimney which is made out asphalt, so we have to replace it. Since it's made out of cancerous product, it will take a specialized company to take it down and it will cost \$18,500 and we will also have to replace the furnace and it will cost close to \$10,000. March 18th the plumber is coming to replace all our lead pipes in the building because in two years it will be not allowed in France to have lead pipe in any building or homes. Enclosed is our itinerary for our furlough to the U.S. this Summer, and I wish we could visit every one of you but unfortunately it won't be possible otherwise it would take us 6 to 8 months away from the Lord's work in Paris.

Lots of our church members are facing sickness and need our prayers. Nodia Milcent with Cancer, Neela Cottineau also with cancer, Cirline Pierre breast cancer Jean Fenestil with a kidney replacement.

Everything is going up, price of gas is between \$9.10 and \$9.90 a gallon, our health insurance went up by 8%, water went up by 10%, car insurance by 7%, and of course everything else, like meat, fruits, vegetables, and public transportation, as bus, train, subway , toll roads, rent in Paris went up by 10% etc ! Like a French man would say "C'est la vie" "It's life".

Dear ones thanks for all the encouragement, spiritual and material support that you have provided us through the years.
