CAMEROON REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2013

It is indeed another blessed moment for me to come your way again with the joyful news of some of the things that Jesus Christ has done through us in Cameroon missions in July. In this report, I hope to share the bright news of considerable conversions of souls to Christ. Also, I will share with you the state of affairs of the church in Limbe. You may also want to hear what our radio evangelism is accomplishing in the body of Christ down here. Generally, I wish the pictures with their depiction of the evangelistic actions could speak louder than the words of this mid-year report.

So, let's begin with issues directly involving our main aim, namely, evangelism. I am pleased to witness the steady increase in the number of those whom the Lord our God has called through the preaching of the gospel. I happy to present to you the following new converts who se lives have been touched and changed to conform no longer to the pattern of this world. Very early in July a young man surrendered to

Christ. So I baptized him. His name is Raphael Panyol, a francophone. It very sad that ever since Brother Raphael was baptized he has never worshipped with the church. The obstacle is his family members. His mom and dad are pagans, and do not want any of the members of the family to have anything to do with any church. To the family, the 19 year old Raphael's action of trying to follow Christ is strange and abnormal. Unfortunately, the pressure seems to have been stronger than he can handle. Please pray for this persecuted new convert. Your prayer can change the situation as it was when Peter was in prison. With your prayer, the young brother Raphael can gain his freedom to worship with the Washing Point Church of Christ just like brother Neba Louis whom we also baptized in the same month. Neba has been faithful in attendance. In addition to Neba, we also have brother Denke Edwin. In my own assessment, brother Edwin is the most wonderful new convert the month of July witnessed. Edwin is in his early 30's with an unquenchable hunger and thirst for righteousness. According to his testimony, he had been listening to us on radio for about three months before he finally made up his mind to obey the gospel. He did. Today Edwin is rejoicing like the Ethiopian eunuch. Conversions like these ones keep us believing that the gospel is indeed the power of God unto salvation.

We will continue to believe in the power of the gospel regardless of what denominational preachers are saying against the Church of Christ. The social gospel of health and wealth has come to our people here. Our congregation is growing rapidly as more and more people are resolved to no longer be charmed by the world's delight.
