What happened?

A number of years ago, there was a television documentary about the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The question was, "Was Jesus Christ really raised from the dead?"

There is nothing wrong with that question. However, the question was not asked of any legitimate scholar. Everyone who was interviewed was a skeptic.

So, what was the purpose of the documentary? Was it to discredit Christian

beliefs?

It is my understanding that eyewitness testimony carries a lot of weight in the courtroom. Did you know the Bible says

over 500 eyewitnesses saw Jesus after His resurrection. They had seen a dead corpse that was now alive.

Yes, I know it all sounds farfetched. But if I had buried someone and three days later seen that person walking around and even eating, I would not be able to keep quiet about it. Jesus followers didn't keep quiet. And we don't keep quiet today.

But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men. But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead,...(1 Corinthians 15:12-20).

Email From Nigeria rec'd June 4, 2013

Dear brother Holloway,

Greetings to you and to the Church. Thanks your for the information on the deposit. I appreciate the grace of God and the graciousness of the brethren there. I left Jos on Saturday, the 1st of June to the Niger Delta. Our bus was attacked on the road by armed robbers. They driver refused stopping for them despite the road block they made. They started shooting sporadically, one the bullets hit the woman who sat just in from of me, and she died. She was pregnant, and had 3 tiny children who travelled with her. The trauma has affected me since then till now. I have not experienced this before, please keep me in prayers. My classes are on, but I keep remembering the poor woman that was killed in the bus. I am to stay here for the next two weeks. I am teaching Christians Evidence and Use of English to these preachers down here.
