Dear family in Christ,

Greetings from a rainy Paris and nearly all of France have rain and flooding too. Like the proverb says "When it rains, it pours"! We are having rain like we have not had for a long time. I know that some of you in the states wish they had that kind of rain.

In regard to my surgery, it went well but instead of taking care one thing they took care of three things polyps, fissure and hemorrhoids. The first two weeks I had terrible pain, and like my French friend Herve told me "That I will remember the pain for the rest of my life" and I confirm that it is true.

While in the hospital one of the student nurses that took care of me came from Persia and of course the subject of our conversation turned quickly to religion. She is not Muslim but Orthodox, and after a long conversation she told me about her future father in law that he was very much interested about the Bible, and she gave me his name and address. As soon as I feel better I will be visiting him and see if I cannot begin a study with him.

I have a new student from the website and he lives in a small town near Nancy which is East of France. He requested a BCC and so far he is doing well and has lots of good questions. I am in contact with a priest who is open to the Bible teaching and even tells people that baptism is not supposed to be by sprinkling but by immersion, he also teach that Easter is not a Christian holiday but Jewish, and that Christmas was instituted by the Catholic church and that the Bible makes no mention of it.

These past two months we were blessed by two precious souls added to the Kingdom. The first one was on the 14th Joëlle Almada's a young woman of 22years, who had been coming to worship for some time. Presently she is in Marseille until September. The second baptism is Benedicte the daughter of Liliane and Godefroy Kitondo was baptized the 26th of May by her father right after Bible class.

In April 722 tracts were taken and in May 1,057. The website is really doing great in April 7,606 people visited our site and in May 7.172 from 73 countries. Several members of the congregation have been sick, Brother Wisgath, Sister Colette Chao underwent surgery, Georgette Renée Gabriel, Enyo, Marguerita Arkan pregnant and having to stay home resting until the birth of the baby in September. In MAY we had the visit of Joyce and Wilfred Deschamps from Mauritius Island and they were with us for about a week.

Then Rose and I were invited by Paul & Edie Tews to join them in Southwest France for a 4 days visit in the small village of Durfort, known for their copper pots and pans. We were very happy to see them and spend that time with them, but unfortunately the weather was bad. They worshiped with us on their way back to England.

Presently I have two persons taking Bible correspondence courses. Mr Chaumeil a contact from the website and Thomas Heymans French young men who has been coming to worship on a regular basis and for the last couple of weeks I have been in contact with a young Algerian man in Alger's. All of the North African countries are Muslim. What is frustrating is the fact the Minister of

the Culture of Algeria was invited by the French authorities to come and inaugurate a Mosque in Tournus near Dijon. Meanwhile he closed 10 churches (denominations) in Algeria and declared publically that he compares "Evangelization" to terrorism.

As you all probably know France has voted same sex marriage, and will allow the same sex couple to adopt children. The world is on a very bad path but this should not stop us on teaching the good news. Presently France with a socialist government is facing difficulties, employment is growing rapidly and the cost of living he keeps on going up and up and with it, taxes keep on going up and up. So therefore we are having several public manifestations in France. But as the Apostle Paul said in 1Tim 2:1-4 "*1 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, in order that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. 3 This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.*"

We are thankful unto to God for every one of you that pray for us and the Lord's work in the French world and make it possible for us to continue to serve Him. Thank you for your financial support.

We love you and you are in our mind and prayers! May God bless you.
