My very dear brethren,

I salute you all in Jesus name. I always thank God because of your labour of love, as you partner with us in claiming Africa for Christ. May the grace of Our Loving Savior be multiplied unto you, individually and collectively. The month of April is just gone, and we are in May. We thank God for last month and appreciate Him for a great new month ahead. Rainfall has started in Jos, with several warning from weather forecasters that this year will witness unprecedented floods. We know that our God is able to save us through every storm.

Thank you for understanding with me when cyber thieves broke into my email box to correspond with all the people in my contact. I am deeply sorry for the embarrassment this had caused you. Fortunately, the miserable thieves did not know that I don't have a daughter. It was easy for people in Nigeria to figure out that it was hijackers, because most of them know my family. Please, let me

mention here that I don't ask for help in that manner. If I have any need, I surely will let the Ellabell congregation know about it. They will be the one who will coordinate such help to get to me. If anyone asks you to pay any money into a certain account in my name, please know that he is a fraudster. Thus, kindly disregard such requests.

I mentioned to you in my last report of the Church in Foron Mission that is experiencing a trial of faith at this time. The Church in now made up of only women and children. The men have left the village because of terrorism. The few sisters left are now in need of someone who will be leading them as even the preacher is relocating. Their husbands are not Christians. I have been there twice last month, and will be going there every Sunday until we get someone who will assist me. Foron Mission is quite far from Jos. It is about an hour drive from Jos. At Mazah congregation, our Friday Bible congregation is going on well.

On the 3rd of May, I will be leaving Jos for Abuja with a team of ten students to campaign the Federal capital for Christ. It will be a nine day activity of door knocking and public preaching. Do keep us in your prayers, especially this time that terrorist group are terrorizing the country in a bad way. Our annual lectureship comes up from 20th -23rd May. People are scared of coming to Jos, especially those from the southern part of the Country. Last year we could not host the program because of chaos. Please, do pray for those who have sacrificed their lives to come. May God continue to keep you in His Love. My wife and children send their love to you all.
