Dearest loved ones,

This will be my last report before entering the clinic tomorrow for my surgery. Normally if everything goes well I will be in the clinic for 4 days and for will have to rest for three weeks after coming home! I should be in good shape Lord willing if there are no complications.

February was a month with many people sick and many lost loved ones. Sister Enyo has lost another cousin back in Togo and so far in a period of 3 months, she has lost ten people in her family, and she will be undergoing surgery on March 19th. I will be having mine on March 20th. Brother Christian Cotineau's wife, Neela is fighting cancer and is back in the hospital getting her chemotherapy. Sister Claudine Lepante's husband passed away on Saturday March 2nd from cancer, and the funeral was held on the 7th. Our old Vietnamese

sister Fournier passed away in Grenoble 5 hours away from Paris, at the age 86 years old from a stroke. Unfortunately we could not make it to the funeral as I was not physically in shape to travel.

On Sunday March the third, I baptized Asias Saintlis, a young man from Saint Martin Island, after I studied with him a few times. He has been coming to worship regularly and finally the Sunday before his baptism he asked if he could be baptized the following Sunday? The four contacts that came from the website have quit coming, apparently they didn't agree some of the teaching. Friday the 15th I received a phone call from a French man and he told me "That he visited our church website and found it very interesting". On Saturday the 16th we had our gospel meeting and we had a really good turnout of 76 were present. Lots of visitors and lots of good questions were asked, in fact the next day one of the visitors came to worship.

In three weeks 847 tracts were taken from our building and I have known that people from the neighborhood come in and took some tracts. The number of visitors to the church website has increased every month! (7446 visitors in one month and from 64 nations.) Averaging around 6000 visitor per month. I have finished a new PowerPoint presentation on "Who is the true Israel Today" Whenever I get better I will have it translated into English.

We are grateful unto each one of you that have prayed for me and are continuing to do so, grateful for your phone calls and cards and word of encouragement , and thank you for your financial support.

We love you and you are in our prayers! May God continue to richly bless you.

I hope you all are doing well. Roland does not have any cancer and is doing better though still on medications and healing. Several of us have lost family members so it has been a sad time. Neela Cotineau is fighting cancer. Claudine lost her husband in March. Sister Fournier dies in Grenoble.

Asias Saintlis was taught and baptized by Roland. He has been coming faithfully for some time now and studying with Roland. In 3 wks time, 847 tracts were taken from our building. The website has an average of 6,000 visitors each month from 64 different nations.

Honoree, Yann, Veronique and Victorien haven't been coming to studies lately. Hope that changes but our doctrine was so different from what they have been taught? Time will tell. Pray for our studies. Thank you all.

I still have my classes with Amelie and she bought ma a French book on 250 ways to crochet. I've been trying to learn some new ways to crochet.

James Saint Louis is still faithful and always the first to arrive for classes. I also am still having English/Bible classes with Natalie Nguyen. Thanks to all who prayed for her Mother Ly as she is doing better.

We miss our kids in the USA and grandkids but am glad all are working and Antony and Steve are taking university classes.

Prayers for John Black and family as they prepare to change work and residence and for all those who have lost loved ones. We are mindful of so many of you that have also lost family lately. I miss my cousin James Space and thanks to all that prayed for him.
