A Monkey and a Typewriter

How long would it take lifeless chemicals under ideal conditions to evolve into a living protozoan? Answer: it could never happen!

Let's simplify the problem. When it is announced that someone is sick, DO YOU send them a card, offer help, visit them in the hospital, or get irritated with announcements about people you don't even

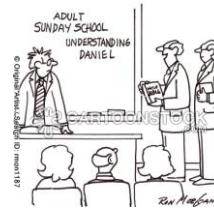
When new souls are added to the church, new members place membership, or people respond asking for prayers DO YOU introduce yourself and welcome them and encourage them?
