Sometimes, when you hear of what are happening over here regarding security situation, there seem as if there are made up stories. But they are true stories. Things are getting from bad to worse, I knew things will be like that except God intervene. Last week in Benue State, the insurgence engaged the use of chemical weapons on people. Several people died. But I know the greatest danger of this is the long lasting effect on the gene of those who inhaled the chemical. As I mentioned in my February report, our street has been here marked for attack. We are not bothered, because we know God is on our side. Last week Saturday 22 March, some people came raining stones on the roof of students' hostel. Well, we thank God because no one was hurt except those who ran into the nearby bush.

The month of March was a busy one for us. Preparations for the 25th year celebration of the School and our 11th annual lectureship are on top gear. We hope God will make these events a success. Since the month of February, our evangelism effort was extended to another two Local Government Areas of Plateau State. Angwari is the Local Government Area council of Jos East LGA. We have gone to this place severally, and have made several contacts. We are hoping that we will have a congregation established here soon.

The next place we are working on is Du district of Jos South. Though there is a congregation in Jos south, this place we are working on is too far from the Church meeting place that people cannot go there. We are hoping also to establish another congregation here. Well, the major road block we have so far is the existing of some major denominations. People are afraid leaving these big long standing religious bodies to start anything new. But I know that it will take time for people to



come to realize the difference between error and the truth as they have been deceived over the decades. We will persist in telling them the truth. Keep praying for us. At Mazah, the Lord added two souls to the Church. My three month class with the youths of Ring Road

Congregation ended today 30th March. I am glad I had the opportunity of equipping these youths against heretical teaching flourishing our country. Without giving them sound standing, the church will not have a future.

Let me once again thank you all for standing up for Jesus to ensure that some people heard the Gospel. Let me use this opportunity to wish all our sisters a "Happy Mothers' Day." I pray that they will continue to be of great influence for good. May God bless our mothers, we love you all.

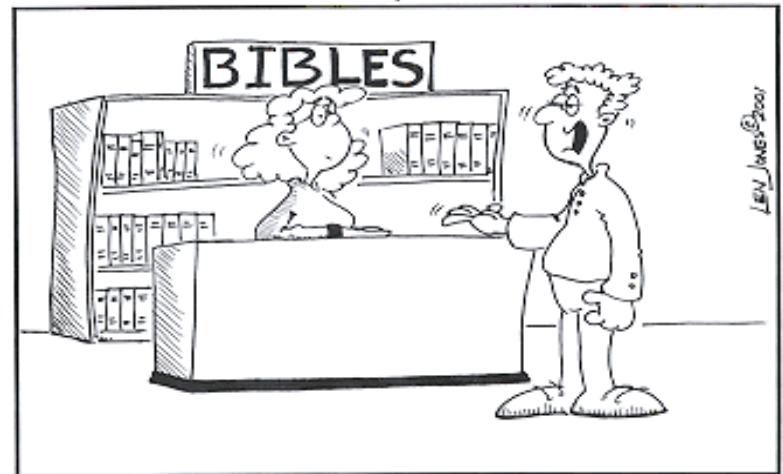
Just got your letter a couple of days ago and wanted to say hi and hope all is going well. I don't keep in touch like I should,

but we still talk of you and continue to try and support when we can. I just got on your website, and it is wonderful.

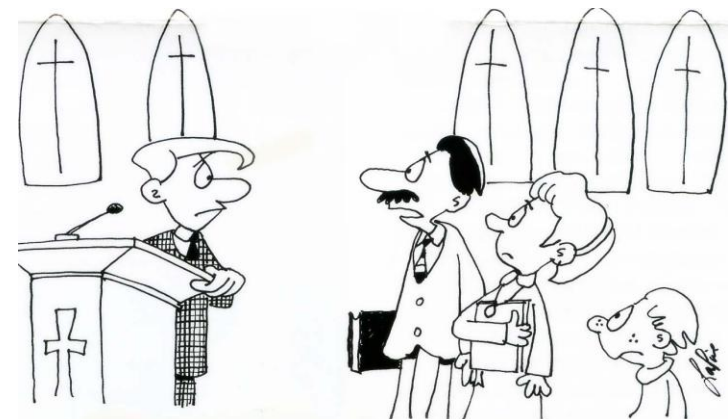
