My beloved brethren in Christ,
 God bless you. I write this report with a lot of joy in my heart. The reason for the joy is Christ. And why do I rejoice because Him? I rejoice because His goodness and His mercy follow us everywhere as we labor in the ministry with the West African missions. The following paragraphs intend to simply unfold how I have been a witness of His goodness in the month of January 2014.

First and foremost, let me focus on the family. As you can notice in this family picture, everyone in my family is doing well. Prof has not been sick for quite some time, and we thank God for his health. Nsikanima is equally advancing in her elementary studies. My wife, Sister Lamikat is doing well as well. I

myself am okay although the responsibilities of serving the family and the brethren can sometimes be very demanding. That is what God's unimaginable grace can do! To Him alone be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations of this grace-driven preacher's household.

From my household let me turn your attention to the household of faith at Washing Point, Limbe. This is equally a subject of importance for this



report. Our point of emphasis in this aspect is that the church is growing as we abound in the work of the Lord daily basis. Not minding the sketchy nature of our unfinished building, this particular Church of Christ believes so much in soul-winning. The church places a lot of emphases on evangelism. This main emphasis of our congregation is the great commission. With God's help

and with our partnership together, we are concentrating on the mission as fishers of men. This concentration on the commission has many angles that we carry out concurrently. The radio preaching (4 hours a week), the invitations to prospects, the personal evangelism of one on one and house to house, are the various angles of our evangelistic outreaches.



The radio preaching, for instance, is gaining ground in the city of Limbe and in some parts of Buea. Many souls have already been baptized as a result of the radio preaching effort. The most recent radio preaching related conversion is that of Brother Rene from Mile 4. He had been listening to us on radio since August last year. He finally decided to give his life to Christ during the month under evaluation.



Rene is not alone in the decision to become a member of the Church of Christ. Others have equally seen the need to take that decision. I am referring to people like Ernest Nchinda whom I baptized in the night this same January. You can see the darkened picture of his baptism. In addition to Ernest, we were blessed with another soul. His name is Ayafor. He is a member of Sister Pauline's extended family. Sister Pauline is one of the pioneer members of the then Mile One church (now Washing Point).

Her husband, Pa Ndenge is one of the most devoted members of the congregation now. Thank God that through their influence, brother Ayafor is now in the Lord.

Those are the ways in which I personally have been a witness of His goodness in the month of January 2014. Also, I know that these wonderful works could not have been performed without the assistance of brethren like you who support us in a number of ways, especially prayerfully and financially. We thank you immensely for joining with us to do this great work in Cameroon. Receive our thanks and remain blessed until Christ comes.



TEACH YOUR CHILDREN

ALMOST EVERYONE AGREES that the example parents set for their children is of paramount importance. Unless we model the standards we desire for our children, it isn't likely they will value them.

The following list isn't exhaustive. Neither is it meant to be authoritative. But it does represent some of the specific things I believe parents need to teach their children. Because you care about your children's welfare in this life and in their place in eternity, please teach them to...

1. **...know that God loves them** and wants to provide what is best for them in keeping with his perfect knowledge and wisdom;
2. **...love God and love others** as they love themselves;
3. **...fear God and keep his commandments** above everything;
4. **...show respect for people and things deserving respect.** Help them know the standard by which to judge this;
5. **...know the blessing of worship** on the Lord's day and the fulfillment of worship with others of like faith in God's family;
6. **...accept responsibility for their actions**, rather than shifting accountability to others;
7. **...be honest** in their dealings with others, as well as their thinking about themselves;
8. **...understand the basis for faith in God**, and the source of salvation in Jesus Christ as the Son of God;
9. **...appreciate the place of the church in God's will**, and the importance of their place in the family of God.

Real success is possible only as we learn to live in keeping with the will and wisdom of God. These principles can't be taught in a day. But if parents will use the time they have with their children to model the value of godly principles, they will have a solid basis upon which to build a life of eternal value.
