Beloved family in Christ, greetings to all of you.

This our last report for 2013 and it's our prayers that your holiday's seasons went well.



In October few of us from the congregation went down to Lyon, for a surprise going away party, for Charles and Pam White, all altogether we were 54, lots of emotion mixed with Joy, but we were sad to see them going back to the States after serving the Lord for close to 40 years, they had to go back first of all for health reason, and the fact that their health

insurance would no longer cover while in France.

Right after coming back from Lyon I took Sister Betty Dupros to Tours which is 3 hours' drive from Paris, she had to go there to finalize her daughter registration so she could study in the states, their car was broke down and no one else could helped them, so I did not mind helping them.

November 2nd I celebrated the marriage of Brother Rosny Vixama with sister Veronique Caloc both of them from our

congregation it was a wonderful wedding and reception close to 300 people were invited to the wedding, the couple rented a place outside the church building, it was a good thing, because our building would not be able to fit everyone.

November 11th close to 40 of us from the congregation went for the annual retreat in Lille, and this year it was our congregation in charge of the program which was based on Romans chapter 12:1-2, I was one of the two speaker, all together 118, which was lot more than last year, it's always good to see brethren which you have not seen for a year and some for more than a year.

November 28 till December the 2nd five brethren we went down to the annual preachers meeting which was held north of Macon, 4 ½ hours' drive du south from Paris, and this year it was our turn to prepare the program and the theme of the meeting, it base on genesis 17: 1-2 I was the first speaker, the meeting went well and encouraging to see each other at least once a year.

December 18th our oldest member brother Lorius Louverture, passed away and went on to be with the Lord, he was 93 years old sweet little old man. But we had to wait till January the 3rd to proceed with funeral because the family was waiting for his two sons to come from Haiti, but unfortunately the French government would not issue their visa.

As for Rose and I we went to Rosemary family for Christmas and for New Year eve we were together with the church and we had close to 200 people present members and friends and we had really a great time all together , exhortation from God's word, singing praying , playing game and of course lots of food.

At last I have finished my PowerPoint presentation title "Who is the Israel of God today?" based on Galatians 6:16 I am happy that it's on the French website Lord willing he will be on the English side soon.

Between October and December close 16000 people visited our website and for the whole year more 104000 from 71 countries.

One of the contact from the website Mendez Steven 21 years old from Colombia South America but living and working in Caen France contacted me and expressed his desire to obey the Gospel by being baptized for the remission of his sin , he plan to come to Paris and be baptized February the 3rd. In 2013 we were blessed with 8 baptisms.

In regard to the 1634 tracts and pamphlet were taken from the church for in the last three month.

Many thanks to all of you who are praying and make it possible for us to continue to spread the gospel in France and the French world.

We love you and ask God to continue to bless with good health and spiritually
