For instance, we are no longer worshipping in a rented place because we took the bold initiative of originating our own building development. This achievement could not have become true without the generous partnership of people like you. We are very grateful for every supportive gesture you have demonstrated toward what we are doing in Cameroon for Christ and His kingdom.

The fruits of these combined efforts are manifested in many ways. Outstanding among the results of our teamwork is the relentless addition of souls to the body of Christ. With this team spirit, we were able to evangelize so many people in the month of May. Thanks God a soul is now a new member of the body of Christ in Limbe. Her name is Linda.



See me baptizing her at the Washing Point stream. Excited to remember that there is joy in heaven when one soul repents and obey the gospel! Please, do remember Linda in your prayers. She is a widow in her early 30's. Her husband, a young lawyer, died about two years ago in an auto crash. Linda is now a single mother having to take care of their 4-year old son, Ryan, unaided. The entrance of the gospel into her life and situation has brought peace and consolation because she now has the assurance that it is well with her soul. Glory to God, and many thanks every co-worker in the vineyard, (or gospel-yard) of the Lord.

Our preaching work is growing stronger and wider. As I said before, we now preach on two radio stations, EDEN RADIO (FM 98.1) and ETERNITY GOSPEL RADIO (FM 96.5). In addition to these 6 hours of weekly soul-transforming LET THE BIBLE SPEAK program, I also have several opportunities to preach to thousands of residents of Buea, Tiko, Mutengene, Limbe and other towns in the southwest region of Cameroon. We thank God for all these



opportunities to preach His word.

Back home in the church at Washing Point, we are more determined to complete the raising of the walls of our building and the roofing.

Notwithstanding, the situation of the church building, the brethren are

courageous and optimistic that one day this setback will become history. Attached to this report is the estimate of what the Washing

Point Church of Christ needs in term of materials to complete the project. All we need for now is just to raise the walls and put windows and doors with a roof over our head. That is all. For now we don't care about electrification or any other luxury. We just need the building materials like cement, gravel, roofing sheets etc. The church is really suffering a great deal of "slow down" a result of the poor environment where we gather to study God's word and to worship. However, we have a lot of reasons to be a happy congregation serving the Lord with gladness and singleness of heart. We are always full of gratitude for the generous financial support over the years. Our attitude toward you is gratitude. Your desire to see God's kingdom spread around the world is demonstrated in your generosity toward the preaching work in Cameroon.
