As I mentioned in my last report, we got some threat alert of attack. Well, just as there was some power prevailing against the man of sin, the prayers of the faithful are being heard by God. We know the Devil will not repent, but God is able to make his power come to naught in the lives of His Children and for His children's sake. In the month of February alone, over 100 people

were killed by the terrorists in the Northern Nigeria. One of the cruel attacks was the one where 29 school children were murdered in cold blood while sleeping in the school dormitory. During last week, confusion broke in some part of Jos that led to the death of some people. Since then, the city is under some tension. However, we were able to worship yesterday without any problem, even though we were guarded by some armed policemen. But the psychology of seeing a police standing outside with automatic gun is enough to create panic. I did not grow up seeing guns every day, not to mention people guarding worship places with guns. I sometimes wonder what type of children our nation is producing for the future. We believe God in His power will make it possible for normalcy to return, so that we can assemble for worship without any form of fear of attack. The attacks on the people of Foron continue. It becomes difficult to predict the attackers' movement as they adopt a kind of guerilla war strategy.

My Sunday class with the youths in Ring Road Congregation has entered its 3rd month this March. Hopefully, the class will come to an end in the next four Sundays. We are studying on prophecies concerning apostasy. This is aimed at grounding believers in the truth of God concerning His Church. Just like many other places, Pentecostalism is influencing several people, and some have thought the Church should tilt a little to accommodate such people. Well, it becomes necessary that Christians start realizing what the Church is, and what it is not. While struggling to bring more people into the fold, we have to secure the faith of the saved ones. My Friday-class at Mazah is going on well. We are studying More precious than gold, looking into the life of brother Job, that in all his challenges, he never thought of quitting his faith. The Lord added one soul to His Church. An average aged man, named Anthony was baptized on the 23rd February. Keep him in prayers.

In the School, we are preparing for our 11th annual lectureship coming up in May. Since I am the coordinator of this program, I have to contact well over 30 speakers across the country and beyond. Several people are afraid of coming to Jos. Some preachers who would love to come are refused by their congregations. I understand with them. But my challenge to them is that since we are alive in Jos, they can come in and go back alive. This is where faith must swallow up fear. Keep praying for us. I thank God for those who have agreed to come. This same May, the School of Biblical Studies is having its Silver Jubilee celebration. We do not

know yet what will happen, but we trust God that He will remain for us.
