Dearly beloved, Greetings to you all in Jesus name. My wife, Sandra and two boys equally say their greetings and wish you a peaceful Spring season. This gives us another opportunity to express our opportunity to say thank you for your individual prayers. Once again, God has seen us through another month of the year despite all the threats. Our faith has increased again in our Lord's sovereign power. He has promised to be with us even to the very end of the age. He continues to show His commitment to that promise.

The month of April might not have offered us all our expectations, but God was faithful in fulfilling His will. As some of you might have heard of the abduction of over 200 young girls from a secondary school by the members of the terrorist group (Boko Haram, meaning Western Education is evil), the situation is still the same. About 7 members of the Church in that locality were taken away by these evil people. Please, keep praying for God to act again, for these girls to be released to their parents. This ugly event happened a day after the Federal capital city was bomb, leading to the death of about 72 people. This is to mention but just a few of the life threatening events. Life becomes a little frightening in the face of all of these. But nothing

is beyond our Maker. Come this Saturday, some of my students, numbering 12, will be in Abuja knocking doors for 9 days. It was difficult to have adequate attention during our last year's outing in the same Abuja. We hope the recent happening will pave a way for us to reach the people with the Gospel. Please, keep praying for us.

Our labour at Foron is yielding results. As I mentioned sometimes back, all the men in the Village of Foron mission stopped coming to the Church, while others left the village. We are glad because two of the men are back to the Church. They have realized that they cannot protect themselves except God does it alone.

At Mazah, we faced another setback on our building last week, as a section of it was damaged by storm. The building is on the pick of hill. Therefore, every storm every year seems to locate the building. It is amazing because the congregation is a small one. Hence, any damage of any sort tells much on the congregation.

We are grateful to God because the man from Toro has completed his two year training in Bible and will be returning to work with the congregation. Brethren, I would not have been able to support him for the two years if not for your help. This support continues as the small congregation with average collection of \$4 a week will not be able to take care of this preacher. I do not want him to move to another place either like the other did. I believe as the congregation grows, they will gather muscle for any task. But for now, they need some kind of push. We continue to solicit for your continuous help to be able to accomplish such task. The School of Biblical Studies, Jos, will be celebrating its 25 years of existence on the 17th May. We pray that we will have a peaceful atmosphere to have this occasion. Following that will be a three day lectureship that I do coordinate. I have invited speakers all around the country. Pray with me that they will have safe passage. Some have already notified me of their inability to come. I know it is due to security problem. People are afraid coming this way. But the fact is that death will come when it will come. Immediately after the lectureship on the 21st of May, I will be leaving for two weeks to Nasarawa State, to train some local preachers. Keep praying for us. Once again, thank you all for your kind assistance, especially as you pray for us
