

house. She apparently felt the need to care for the things of the house. She was “cumbered” or burdened down with much serving. She must have felt very close and comfortable with Jesus. After a period of time she scolded, “*Lord, do you not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? Bid her therefore that she help me.*” Jesus responded, “*Martha, Martha, you are careful and troubled about many things. But one thing is needful: and Mary has chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her*” (Lk. 10:40-41).

Certainly having Jesus in the house was a blessing. Yet Martha was too busy to enjoy the blessing. God gives us a multitude of blessings each and every day. One of the greatest blessings of life is our mate, children, grandchildren and friends. However, are we busying ourselves with things that really do not matter?
