REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2015 (TOM EKPO JR)

Dear brethren, on behalf of my family, I greet you all in Jesus name. We are grateful to God who has seen us this far. We had no idea that we will be among the living this day. It is the grace of God. We owe Him all the praises and thanks. We equally express our deepest thanks to all of you who are part of the progress in reaching the lost souls in Africa and strengthening the young congregations to weather the adverse tormenting conditions affecting Christianity in Northern Nigeria.

The month of November was a busy month in Nigeria because of the series of activities people have, both social and religious activities. At the School of Biblical studies, we rounded up the semester on the 27th of November. But during the month, my students were very helpful to me. They accompanied me for several of my outings. Village congregations were always so excited to see a bunch of them come in for worship. I am grateful that I have such students who love God and are willing to help local congregations. At Mazah congregation, I taught 3 classes on Fridays on

the book of 1 Corinthians. They are excited about the book. We went out for Saturday door knocking for three weeks. At the Campus Church of the University of Jos, I had only a class on Sunday. The congregation, which is made up mainly students, needs assistance. They are very few in number sometimes upto twenty when the school is in session. God's willing, this coming year, I will be moving around congregations pleading for help for them to roof their building. The building is located in a safe area, but the road leading to the venue is a deadly road because of the Muslims that populate the area. Keep praying for them. To the honor of God, a soul was brought to Christ. He will be worshipping with the Campus congregation even though he is not a university Student yet, because of his proximity to the Congregation. We are trying to reach out to non-students so that the congregation can keep on worshipping when the students are on vacation.

The village of Foron has witnessed peace one month now. Even though the road leading to the village has been deadly because of the Islamic militants operating along that road, yet the village has not been attacked for the past one month. I believe it is answered prayer. We do not know how long this will continue, but we are grateful that people have been able to sleep in their homes. The Church is therefore doing great. We plead that you keep praying for them. I taught there for two weeks. I pray that the peace will continue so that we can resume our door knocking. Brethren, it is a night mare to live in an unsafe area. I plead with God to open the eyes of those allowing Muslim so called refugees to influx into US. They may not realize the danger they are posing to millions of lives. Am not against the Muslims, I wish I can make all of the Christians. But I am against the evil plans they have. My question is, Why are the Muslim refugees not migrating to Saudi and Iran, and other places that peaceful? I see the plan for the spread of Islam in this scheme.

Unfortunately, some people in power are not seeing what I am seeing. Years from today US and Europe

will face terrible disaster they won't be able to contend with as a result of this single mistake. May God help us. Brethren, as these happen that we have no power over, we must be apt with our Bible. Let us reach to as many as we can with the message of salvation. Islam has determined to conquer the world. It is my determination that it will not conquer me. I want to help as many as I can in Nigeria to arrive at this determination. Brethren, we are grateful to you for the sacrifices you make to help us reach people with the message of Salvation. One interesting thing about this ministry I love so much is the constant check it places on me. The apostle would say, I beat under my body, lest after I preach to others, I would be disqualified (1 Cor. 9.27). May God continue to bless you all in all that you do.
