We pray that you had a wonderful holiday season with your family and friends. As I reflect back on 2014 and the Lord’s work, it has been a blessed year, even though we had a few health problems, we were able to lead 9 precious souls to Christ this year! The last two were ones in November and the other one in December.

Our dearest friend Hebert TAYLOR from Searcy, Arkansas received in Paris the Légion of Honor for his participation during World War II. It was a wonderful to see that as Rose and I were invited.

November 11th we went to the annual retreat of the Churches held in Lille, France and about 30 from our congregation went. The theme for this year was personal growth and congregational growth, and we were a total of 98 present. November 15th Ann Tran’s mother which I had the privilege to baptize her few years ago, passed away. I did her funeral service for

her. Ann Tran's friend, a Thai woman wanted to study the Bible, so I did study with her and Sister Ann a couple times.

Madeleine King, an Irish young woman, original contact from the Church Website has been coming to our English worship regularly for more than 1 month and also taking a Bible correspondence with me, so on the 30th of November she decided to put Christ in baptism.

I send our Mitsubishi space wagon to Simon Parfait evangelist in Cameroon who had worked with us several years ago. It will be very helpful for his work since all of his work had to be done by public transportation. But before sending it to him I filled the space wagon with a bunch of teaching material and equipment which will be useful for his work and the Church there. Simon's Mother is paying to ship the car.

December 17th Dimitri Masselis from Lille was immersed into Christ, as he was also a contact from our website. He is 20 years old and presently at the University of Lille. Brother Vance baptized him.

December 31st the church got together like we do almost every year for fellowship, singing praying and good food to start off the New Year. This year we were 145 altogether, it was nice to start the New Year with our brethren.

Marie Laurence, Colette's friend from school continues to come regularly Sunday mornings for worship and I am continuing to study with her through the Bible correspondence course. Twice a week she comes with Sister Colette to help with work that has to be done for the church.

Every chance that Brother Stiven from Caen can come for worship he does. He came with Dr David Kern and wife Catherine and their 10 years old son Jay from Jonesboro, Arkansas. David was in Caen to teach economics for 5 weeks, so we were glad for Stiven that he had them to fellowship with.

Brother Pierre Mathurin from church was reunited with his wife and 3 children after 3 years of waiting for papers from the French government they have arrived from Haiti. We are happy for them.

In November we had 6,173 visitors from 79 countries and in December 4,880 visitors from 75 countries in our website. The government has announced several **increases** for the 1st of 2015. They are the post office mailing cost 15%, taxes on Gasoline

by 4%, Natural gas by 2%, Public transportation by 2.5%, Electricity by 2.5%. and also the TV taxes, will go up from 133 Euros to 136 Euros.

We are grateful unto all of you that make it possible for us to continue to preach the gospel in the FRENCH WORLD. May God continue to bless you all . Love Roland and Rose
P. S. I started my letter 2 weeks ago, but due to a bad a bad cold I wasn't able to finish it.

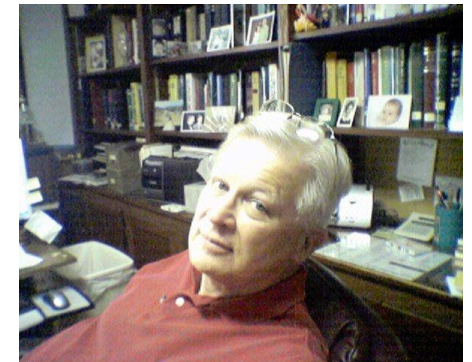
Email from Nigeria (rec' d February 16, 2015)
