

Dear Co workers,

On March 26th Madeleine Elizabeth Mohsen was born, to Michael and Melissa Mohsen, weighing 8 lbs 12 ounces at 12:13 by cesarean. All are fine. We are very blessed and this is our 6th grandchild. Since it is the year of our visit to the states, we are impatient to see her and the family, and all of you that have been behind the Lord's work in France and the French world! We are grateful unto God for all of you that have been praying and making it possible for us to continue to spread the gospel.

Marie Laurence which I mentioned in my last report has been coming regularly to worship and I am continuing to study the Bible with her every time she has free time, but she is also following

a Bible correspondence with me and she is presently on her last lesson and she has expressed the desire to know more about being baptized in Christ for the remission of her sins. Edwige Maussang the young woman continues to come to the Bible class and worship has expressed to me that she wanted to obey the gospel but wanted someone of her family to be present for her baptism. I pray to our Heavenly Father that someone will come, she expected her sister to come a couple weeks ago but she did not show up.

Franck Bayard a 35 year old French barber started to show up one Sunday morning and has come 3 Wednesday night Bible classes. At first he had lots of questions about the Church so I answered them, and on his last visit I gave him the first lesson to a Bible correspondence course.

Another French contact, Jean Luc Sartori who lives with his family in the same street as us. We would say hello, until one day we struck up a conversation and he began asking me about the Church and it's teaching. One day he was telling about his problems with his TV set that was not properly working, so I offered to look at it.

I went to his house looked at the problem and told him no problem I can fix it for him, since I was a former radio electrician and know about TV reception. So I fixed his TV and he was very grateful for it and he asked me "How much He owed me?" I told him "No charge." At the same time I told him "That if he wanted to improved his knowledge of God's word that I had a Bible course that he could follow easily." He accepted my offer and is following the course.

Jean Luc when he arrived to the 5th lesson of the Bible correspondence he told me that he was thinking about being baptized. Time will tell. Rose has helped his daughters with English and some Bible.

Since our congregation was in charge of the program for the annual retreat of the Churches of Christ this year, the theme will be based upon Colossians 3:1-4 , and 11 from the congregation will be going to the Retreat this coming May. We are also preparing for our annual Bible Bowl based on the Book of Romans. A group of young adults from the congregation and some teenagers will be traveling

to Nice, France to help Rony and Veronique establish the Church in that city. They will be giving out tracts and inviting people to study the Bible with them.

Some of the families of the congregation are continuing to go to Brussels to encourage the French congregation who is down to about 4 to 5 people per Sunday.

For the first 3 months of this year, 1,374 brochures and tracts were taken, which makes an average 458 per month. The website continues to have more people visit it and in January we had 5,703 visits from 77 countries in February 4,832 from 75 countries and March 5,184 from 76 countries.

Overall the congregation is doing well and more and more people are getting involved in the activities of the Church, especially the young adults.

Brother George Francisco Barreno from Equator, South America, who was converted in Rome, Italy a few years ago, placed membership with us.

Health wise Rose and I are doing fine. We are looking forward to visit you all and of course our children and grandchildren. We are looking for a new overseeing Eldership for the Lord's Work here and our support. Enclosed is our Summer Itinerary while in the U.S.
