I rejoice greatly for the grace of being a Christian because of the hope laid up for us in heaven. On behalf of my family, I say thank you all for standing with us in the defense of the Gospel. Paul told the Ephesian Christians of the battle they must fight. Brethren this battle is taking a different dimension in our time, but interestingly the weapons remain the same in form and function. The Lord has been with us, leading us as we spread the seed of good tiding, and at the same time endeavor to keep the sheepfold secured. Essentially, we are not the one doing these, but God working in and through us all. May God in His goodness visit and bless every one of you individually and collectively.

You decided to fund the work of missions in Africa not because you were well placed than others, but because of your love for God and the dying souls in Africa. We say thank you. We pray God will continue to help us sustain this work.

The Congregations in Foron (Foron Mission and New Foron) are doing well. Sometimes, I am torn apart as where I need to be

The persistent attacks on these people have made them

to live in constant fear. Several people do not want to come to Church for obvious reason. We have been having lessons on church growth, and we thank God for sustaining the congregation. At Mazah, we are progressing. We have completed the block work on our meeting place. We are now looking for funds to cap the building. Mazah is a small congregation of about 7 families. But their determination to get things done is always encouraging. All of them are those who are struggling to make a leaving. The building is necessary because people in this area pay respect to Church meeting place. Their belief is that any church without a building has no future. Well, we know better than anywhere. However, we need the building so that we can bring in some of these people and teach them the truth. More so, the brother whom we are meeting in his home is relocating to another village in search for business. Our weekly evangelism outreach and Bible classes are going on. My students are of immense help every week as they join in the outreach and worships with them on Sunday to motivate them. We started a new series on the book of 1 Corinthians. Keep praying for us

The Congregation at the University community, made up of mainly students equally needs our regular help and constant prayers. They need me to come in there at least twice a month. But is difficult because of the other smaller congregations in the village that need our presence. It now I really understand Jesus complain

that the field is ripe, but the laborers are few. We pray God to send in harvesters.

I Thought I will make it to Toro last month as they keep calling on me since the burial of the brother last two months. The road leading to Toro is highly risky as some Muslim militants invade the road so often. I want to be with them soon despite all the challenges. I know our Lord will see me through.

As the year comes to an end, the Devil is intensifying his evil tendencies. We pray that things will go well with you all over there. I appreciate the sacrifices you are making to assist us. Beside this, keep us in your daily prayers. May God continue to us for every good work to His glory.
