The month of September came in swiftly and without my notice, has gone by. We are glad that we had the opportunity to witness and experienced the month. Several things went on in the month. Several people dear to me marked their birthday. Still within the month, I had the official convocation of my Doctorate Degree in New Testament Studies at the University of Jos. See the

pictures on the previous page. To God be the glory because He I did not know I would complete the program considering my tight and busy schedule. My thesis supervisor, Prof. Danny McCain, an American Scholar was of immense help to me.

On a sad note, in Jos, we marked 14 years since the Muslims started slaughtering Christians in Jos and its environs. September 7 is the black day in Jos, and I know that September 11 2001 was the unfortunate day the evil incarnates destroyed innocent lives in the twin tower disaster there in US. Since 2001 September, there is no year we do not witness blood shade in Jos. But we are grateful to God because He has kept us safe all these years. For that reason, we have reason to give thanks to God.

Within the month of September, we had our 16<sup>th</sup> annual national preachers and leaders' workshop. A two day program designed to discuss relation issues bothering on preachers and leaders' responsibilities in the Church.
