

**AUGUST 2015 REPORT FROM CAMEROON.....ABASIAMA**

Cameroon missions is on the march. Everywhere you look in the city of Limbe or elsewhere in the country, the Church of Christ is demonstrating a renewed sense of mission for Christ. My heart overflows with gratitude to the Lord and His bridal communities for the amazing work courageously carried out with determination and co-operation. Here in Cameroon, the month of August is characterized by heavy rainfall. That informs the unfolded umbrellas over our head as we preached the gospel and baptized the people.

August report aims at updating all the members of the West African missions with the progress of the work we doing in Cameroon. The report equally seeks to highlight some of the many challenges we face and the boundless joy we share.

In terms of the progress that August work has contributed to the progressively happy history of our preaching endeavors in Cameroon, I will like to first of all invite your attention to the evangelism struggles of the month and its fruits. I know that you are well aware of the unprecedented accomplishments of our radio

Evangelism initiated about five years ago. I am glad to remind you that you have a supportive hand in this radio program. LET THE BIBLE SPEAK is a revolution reminiscent of the Pauline evangelistic expeditions that precipitated so many persecutions. Apostle Paul was alleged to have turned the city of upside down. Some of our listeners have equally accused us of turning the Bible upside down. Some have gone to the extent of seeking the services of Legal practitioners to intimidate us into silence. Some of the Denominations in Limbe have come to realize that the Preaching of the gospel by the Church of Christ is totally supported by the inspired word. The day I will be arraigned in the Limbe Court of First Instance to answer questions on Charges of witch haunting and criticism of denominations may soon come.

In the midst of the oppositions and persecutions we face, we still believe in evangelizing the communities. The fruits of such determination are readily made manifest by the new converts that God keeps adding to our ever increasing membership. You may recall that in July we baptized a very serious Bible student called Cecilia. She is a sociologist. Through her contribution, we have succeeded to teach her daughter Celine whom we baptized in the month under retrospection. She was baptized almost in the night after a Wednesday Bible Class. That is why her baptism pictures are unclear. Please just kindly manage the poor quality of the photos as they are and celebrate with us the salvation of her soul.



Another good news of progress is the baptism of Regina Motale. She is a primary school teacher. She got in contact with the Washing Point Church of Christ through the radio preaching. You could see her in the midst of the congregation as she worships for the first time with the Church of Christ. In utter defiance of the heavy rains in the month, we reach out to so many but only a few answered the gospel call. We thank God for the souls that were saved through the work done in August by all of us.

The church of Christ in Muea town of Southwestern Cameroon is about to launch a television program of preaching. The thought I could be useful to them knowing I have some experience in the media. They have contacted the Washing Point congregation to have me borrowed to present the gospel on Hi TV located in Buea. Tomorrow Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> of September 2015 is the final meeting to decide the Days that I have to travel to Buea to preach the gospel on Television. Please pray that the same success that we have been having on radio will be similarly a characteristic of the TV show.

Well, that is about all I could put together for your information concerning the work in August. However, I cannot conclude with some heartfelt appreciation. Of course you you it is regarding the great contributions and other forms of support that you have shown to us as we struggle day and night with tears to preach the word. Speaking for my family, the orphans and the church in general, I sincerely say THANK YOU ALL and may GOD BLESS YOU.
