

Dear beloved family in Christ,

Greetings to all of you! February is tax time in France. March has been cold, windy and rainy.

The good news is the three baptisms so far this year! After the baptism of Joy Voltaire on January 17th, on Thursday, 21st of February, Quentin Delwasse was baptized into Christ for the remission of his sins. On the 21st of February, I Immersed Rubenson Ceus into Christ. He is a young man who really desires to know more about God's word, so every Wednesday before Bible class, I study with him and on Sundays after worship he comes up to eat with us and afterward we study together.



I am continuing my studies with Jordy Wisgath and pray that he will soon obey. Sometime surprising things happen! About two weeks ago while I was downstairs showing the electrician what was needed to be done, an older man came in and asked "May I come in and pray?" I replied "No problem come in." He did his prayer and afterward I began to ask him a few questions on how he found out about the Church and so on, so he replied "I am living my second life that God gave me after my big illness." "I promised God that since He spared my life I would go to every church Catholic, Protestant, Mosque, Synagogue, Jewish temple, Buddhist or Hindu temple to pray. "He said "So

far I have done it in 110 places and will continue till I fulfill the promise I made to GOD. I explained to him who we were and that I would be glad to study with him, and he replied "Do you know who you are speaking to?" "I am General Fromentin, 87 years old born in 1929 in Dijon". Finally, He finally said " I must go on to fulfilled the promised I made to God!" I offered to give him tracts but plainly refuse to take them.

In February a total of 5,549 people visited our website from 66 countries and in March 5,744 visitors from 72 countries. One of the contacts from the website called me and mentioned the fact that not only he visited our website but also stopped by and picked up several tracts that are available. I tried to get his name but he refused, so I just plainly thanked him for calling and told him that "I was available to answer any questions he would have in regard to the Bible." There were 285 Bible tracts taken from the tract racks, in February and in March 328 tracts were taken.

After installing the bathroom for handicapped people, the same contractors, for the last 3 weeks of March has been electrical rewiring of our building and also our apartment, will be glad they will have finished the work. I must say it was really needed, because the building was no longer to today's standards and if some accident would have happened, it would not have covered by the insurance.

With Isis recent terrorist attacks in France and Belgium, the French government has increased the number of police and army people to patrol Paris! This is good, but on other hand, it's sad to know that Isis people have infiltrated the police and army department. Even some of the Muslim police men refuse to guard any business owned by Jews and refused also to protect any Jewish synagogue or temple.



After using our old 1998 Volvo car for 18 years, which had 242,000 miles on it, we finally brought a new car, a Toyota Auris hybrid automatic and it runs on gas, because our new mayor of Paris, decided that she no longer wanted any diesel engine cars

more than 10 years old running in the city.

We have an American family that placed membership with us, and the husband works at the US Embassy and they will be in Paris for two years. Their names are Ben and Alma Green and have 3 small children and a fourth on the way. Our Sunday night English worship attendance is still down from what it was before all the terrorist attacks, but in the last 3 Sundays' night worship we had several visitors from the United States and a group of students from Harding University which brought up the attendance for the English worship.

Brother Simon Motaze from Cameroon is having eye problems and is needing surgery for his one eye, but the surgery cannot be done in Africa, so therefore he contacted me and since his phone call, I contacted the best known hospital for eyes in Paris and talked to one of the best surgeons and explained the situation. Simon is scheduled to be operated on the 24th of May, and I will pick him up on the twentieth and he will stay with us one month after his surgery. We are praying that he will not have any problems in getting his medical visa to come.

Brother Paul Besse had a surgery to remove a tumor that keep him from seeing well, and after some complications the surgery went well. He is presently recuperating at their apartment.

We are grateful unto God and for all of you who are supporting us spiritually and physically as we continue to strive to teach the Gospel in the French world.
