We will always do our best to give the gospel to the people of Cameroon as we have the possibility. The month of May presented us with on such occasion to preach the word of God in Limbe. The preaching has helped some lost soul to find his way to salvation.

We have been talking about the unprecedented impact of our preaching through Eden Radio. In May the proclamation of the message of Christ on the air led to the baptism of brother Yanick,


