## REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2016 (TOM EK POT JR)

My beloved brethren in Christ, I greet you all in Jesus's name, hope that our good Lord has continued to see you through in your various endeavors. We give God the glory for all His doings in our individual and collective lives. The month of February as usual, was a short month with several activities.



The month has come and gone, but the memories of the month remain. Let me use this opportunity to express our profound gratitude to you for your support and constant prayers. Living in an environment under terrorist constant attack is challenging, but I tell you, all things work for good for those who love God, those who are called according to His purpose (Rom. 8.28). We have

learnt to live each day at a time. We have learnt to understand better that we can make plans, but God determines the outcome. These are some of the things we would have only read and imagine it happening if not God allowing the display of this ugly experience. But these experiences have built up our faith in different ways. Congregations, even though they are small in number, yet have come a long way in the spiritual life. I am looking for a time they will be able to take care of themselves even if I am no more around. God has helped us achieved this in Toro and Bokkos, we are hopeful that Foron will stand in the nearest future. The Church at Mazah is equally growing, because of our weekly evangelism program. My Friday class with them is continuous. The class is becoming very interesting. In the last few weeks, for the first time, we have been recording 85% attendance. We are still studying the book of 1 Corinthians.

At Foron Mission, we are handling Children discipline and self-discipline. We have equally started children classes. Even though there are only 7 children in this congregation, we are organizing the class to attract children from the neighborhood. Hopefully, through these children, we will get to their parents. Even if we are unable to get to their parents, we would have sown the seed of the kingdom in their hearts. This may have financial implication as we need to buy toys and some other learning materials for these children, we trust in God that He will see us through. Keep praying for us.

At the School of Biblical Studies, we have come to half of the semester, hence, the students are leaving for mid-semester break. But the challenge we are encountering that hampers movement in the shortage of gas. Against the low price of fuel in the international market, we buy gas about \$40 per gallon. This makes movement difficult. Nigeria is a country we don't know whether we are going. Whether we are stationary or we are marking time backward. Do pray for our leaders because they are clueless. It is only God who would salvage us from these

problems. I am afraid if things continue like this for long, there will be total revolution. That would be good for the kingdom of God has already suffered set back in the Northern Nigeria.
