

months have also been busy with the Lord's work and one more soul has been added to his Kingdom! It is a Thai woman named



In August we had a Taiwanese family place membership with us, the Wu Philip and Tse Li Yeu and their two children Max and Daniel. Since their first visit we have not seen them. August was also a time of preparation month for the

coming of Daniel and Tammy Frérot from Strasbourg. They held a workshop for us on how to be an effective Sunday school teacher. Both classes were really good. Daniel taught the men while Tammy his wife taught the ladies. **(Pictures left)** It is our prayers that we can bring them back again to Paris perhaps next year.

In September I flew for the first time to Lac Saguenay, Canada where Jean Grenier started a work, and my purpose of this trip was to recuperate old recordings of the late Brother Jacques



Marshall who was the speaker on the radio program "La Voix du Salut" which is The Voice of Salvation. After working in his own town in Namur, Belgium for several years, he moved to Nantes, France, and afterwards to Toulouse, France and then to Canada where he worked with the church while continuing his French radio program. Being sick for a long time he finally went home to be with his Lord.
