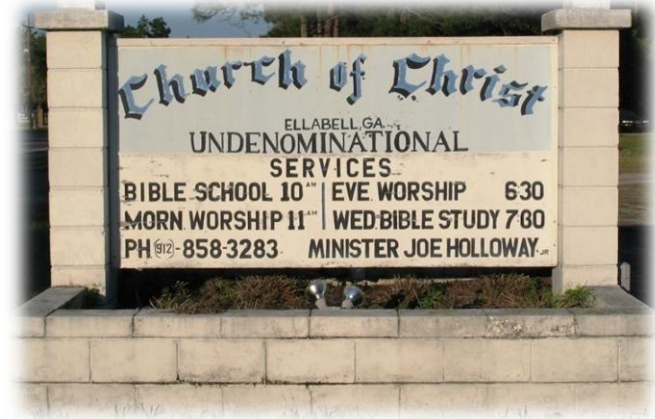

REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER (TOM EK POT JR).

Greetings to you all who love God and eagerly wait His return to take us home. Grace and peace be with you all. We thank God who has seen us through the month of September, especially here in Jos where security has been threatened repeatedly. Thank you for taking time to pray for us. In fact, Jos has become a place in the country that people who are outside Jos would not want to come. When one comes to Jos, people feel he/she is planning to commit suicide. Well, God is with us as you keep praying for us. God added another year to Sandra and Goodnews respectively. Very interesting, Goodnews was baptized on his birthday. So, he is a new creature, and everything becomes new for him. Godswill left for High School. Today being first Saturday of the month was their visiting day. We were able to see him and renewed our togetherness. Please, keep praying for him as he just new in

the environment and in the school. Today also was independent day for Nigeria, but I tell you, everyone was moving in the street in fear because of the series of rumors that militants are planning attack. We wonder what type of independent we had. It came to me again that true freedom is only in Christ.

Notwithstanding all the security threats, several people are still in need of the gospel of Christ. We took advantage of the threatening situation to renew people's hope in Christ. We went out every weekend, preaching the gospel to lost souls. God added one soul to His kingdom. During the month, I had opportunity to travel to a neighboring state called Kaduna State to preach in the opening of a new worshipping hall. Several people gathered, both Christians and non-Christians. Our class with Mazah is going on well. We have erected a temporary meeting place since storm knocked down our former building. Keep praying for us please. I also covet your prayers for the evangelist working with the Toro congregation. You can remember that a year ago, I was able to get one of our SBS graduate to work with the small congregation. He has been doing a tremendous work, and the congregation is moving ahead in several ways. But now he wants to go to another place. I am asking God to help him see the need to stay with them a while. Keep praying for him as he tries to make decision regarding the work in Toro. His presence there had really alleviated my traveling to Toro every week. Nevertheless, may God's will be done. The two congregations in Foron (Foron Mission and New Foron Village) are doing well. Last month we pleaded for your prayers for them because of the attacks they had from some Muslim militants. We thank God because the frequency has reduced. But secret killing continues even in Jos city.

Our 13th annual preachers'/leaders workshop which came up from 28-29 was very successful, even though we had a poor turn up. But heart turning papers were presented. I present a key note address on the "The Church and Education." We are trying to encourage Christian brethren to see the need to open and support schools that teach Christian values, since the world is working so hard to erode the minds of young people with nonsense in the name of education. We are hoping that Christians will take the initiative to indoctrinate people for God.
