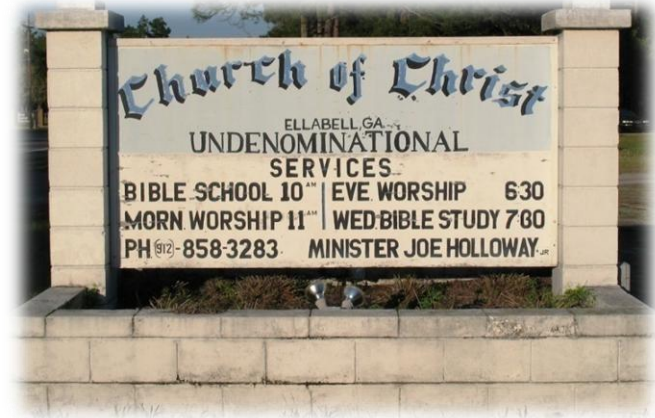
Call List --There are forms on the back pew if you want to be added to our call list. If you want a call made, call me or text me and I will make the call and schedule it. 912-667-0519

THE HELP BROUGHT TO THE NGOUSSO CONGREGATION

We are still working with the Ngousso Church though facing some difficulties as the present leaders of the 3 ministries (adoration, women, and finance) are absent due to their various jobs; and this has caused a problem in the following up of the members. So we have a session work with them to reconsider some basic points in order to make an impact and be more effective in term of work on the Church's present weaknesses.

THE BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER SESSION WITH MY RELATIVES

Monday has known some disturbance due to my absence while in the hospital with my son Moses; the attendance is now about 3 out of more than 12 that already reached during the last meetings.

MY FAMILY LIFE

God has been so merciful to us and particularly Moses during his surgery on his left arm 2 weeks ago, through your support whether in prayers that (we experienced), or financial help up to 350 EUROS NEEDED.

Everything went on well and we have left the hospital where we were admitted. We go there now twice a week and we had an appointment with the doctor to examine if the wounds made during the surgery were healing so that Moses would be given a new medicine plaster cast after 15 days which we did. So please continue to put us in your prayers so that all the process may go well and that Moses may be able to attend the beginning of the new school year, and for me to be free from all these so that I may continue with my ministry work.
