

Dear ones,

May the Lord richly bless you and give you more zeal as you serve Him in 2011.

We are indeed grateful unto God and all of **you** that make it possible for us to continue preaching the Gospel in the French world. The year 2010 was a good one for the Lord's work in Paris; we ended the year with our 10th baptism. Dec. 9th 2010 was the baptism of Miselaine Joseph, a 47 year old Haitian woman with a Catholic background. After several Bible studies with Brother Tremont, Samuel Milcent and me, she understood and decided to be immersed into Christ for the remission of her sins. Victor Caloc, 76 years old was immersed unto Christ on the 26th! It was a

blessing for the family and all of us. Before he obeyed the gospel he always made sure that is family came to Bible class and worship every Sunday, and inspired many of the members by his attitude. Sister Josy Edom moved definitively back to Guadeloupe

especially to be with her Mother, so we had a fellowship meal, gave her a gift, and we sure going to miss her. We had two new families place memberships with us. Daniel and Melissa McCullough and their two children family from Austin Texas, in Paris for 2 months. He came to help someone build an attraction park. They were in culture shock most of time they were in Paris, as it was the first time to live outside of the U.S.A. Then we had the David and Tumelo Moloto family and their 3 children from South Africa, she is a member of the Church, but her husband is Anglican and has been coming with her to worship. He works for Nestle international Company and will be here for the next 3 years. Lord willing we will have the opportunity to teach him the truth.

The Raguél Ceus family was reunited as Brother Raguél was able to bring his whole family from Haiti, and we are sure very happy for him. Now some sad news, our son in law's Dad is dying and Juliette's uncle died. This year for the New Year's Eve party we had more than 180 present! It was well prepared and everyone enjoyed starting the New Year together. January went by very fast, with so many things planned for this year.

The ladies retreat which was held south of Paris in Orsay, brought 83 ladies together for a good two day retreat. It was organized by the sisters in Geneva, Switzerland and Rose was asked to be one of the main speakers.

Pamela McAdams had come from Scotland and stayed with us a week, until it was time for the ladies retreat, and it was nice to see her back in Paris; of course while she was here she did some work for me on website of the church. Sunday the 2nd with the ladies from the retreat we had a record attendance for the morning worship. We had 254 present beating the record of two years ago, of 205 present.

In fact in December we had 3,987 visitors on the website from 37 countries and in January 4,028 visitors on the website from 43 countries; we are praying that some of the ones that visit there will obey the gospel. We are planning to have a Bible bowl in July 2nd based on the book of James, it will be in English and in French, and we will be sending invitations to other sister churches, in France, Belgium, Switzerland and even Scotland, so we have to

prepare for this event. We are also planning a one day retreat for this congregation, like we did last year. It will be a retreat on how to teach others and how to conduct Bible studies to lead someone to obey the gospel.

Well as I am sure you are aware: that everything went up in January, as it was already announced, electricity by 10%, natural gas, fuel diesel from \$7.09 to \$7.81 a gallon, gasoline from \$8.34 to \$9.40 a gallon, car insurance by 7 %, housing insurance by 5%, food, produce, meat , poultry etc. The Internet monthly fee also increased by \$4.40 per month in January and we thank you all for considering all these things.

Helene Donchery and Francoise Bess came up and visited and looked through old photos of the church here and there when they were girls. We had a fun afternoon. The ladies appreciated the sandwich, chips, and bottled water the church here had for them before their trips. Because of Christ, Roland
