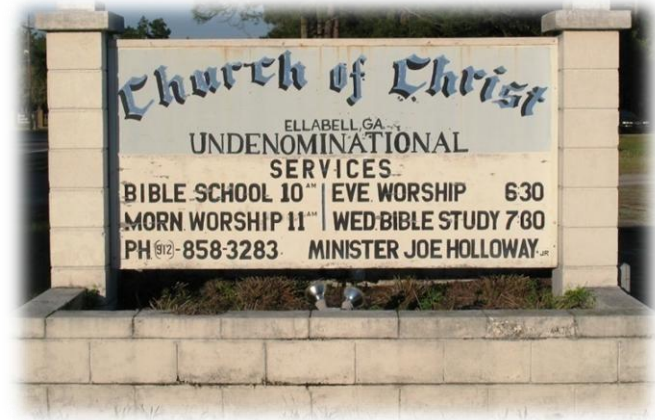

May His peace and grace be available to us all. Thank you all for praying for sister Imaobong who had accident. Her husband came and has taken her down to the South of Nigeria. But he told recently that one of her hands is not functioning until now. Then motor nerves of the right hand were affected, such that the hand is temporary paralyzed. The doctors are optimistic that the nerves will come back on their own. Please, continue to pray for her. Permit me to use this opportunity to condole those who have suffered the recent tornado that hit some parts of Arkansas, Alabama, Tennessee, and Georgia. For some days now we do not have power. It was only this morning that the power company gave us power. I don't know how long this will last. It was then, I saw in the News that natural disaster had hit those places mentioned. I pray God to comfort those affected. At the same time, I sympathize with those kids who suffered burnt. I thank you all for your prayers, especially while Nigerians went to the polling booth to select their leaders. It was horrible in some places, as several lives were claimed through rioting and bombing. The Northern Nigeria has

become one of the most deadly places for one to stay. But despite all such evil tendencies, the grace of God was available for us.

This time, the evil men (Muslim youth) attacked Toro, and burnt several church buildings. We thank God our building is not included, as our building is far removed from the inner city. But the brethren are afraid of gathering as these evil people attack others secretly. Jos situation was not so bad this time, as prompt intervention halted the initial plan. Though some few people were killed, yet it was not like other times. Our evangelism in the city Jos brought two people to Christ this time. Join us in appreciating God for His kindness.

In the next two days, I will be out of Jos for 9 days knocking doors in Benue State. We are having our annual evangelism campaign for Christ in several places years. I am taking a team to Benue State. Keep praying for us, even as I leave my family behind. On the 14th of May, we will be having our Graduation ceremony. On the 16th through 19th of May we will have our annual Gospel Lectureship. Preachers are coming all over the Country and even outside Africa to attend the program. Please, keep us in prayer that there be no civil unrest to disrupt this plans. However, we pray that God's will be done. Once again, we appreciate you for helping us, May God meet you all at the point of your individual and collective needs. As you help us, God will surely help you in several ways both in this life and the one to come.

February we were busy in the preparation and the planning of all the yearly activities for 2011. We made lots of good contacts and praying that some of them will be able to be taught the gospel. One of the contacts I met, it was at MacDonal'd's, a young Lebanese, woman. She was reading her Bible and of course, I began by telling her that it was rare to find people reading the Bible in public in our days. We had a good conversation and I gave her the address of where we meet.

Another contact was near a metro station, where that lady from Kabylie , had a stand giving out Bibles in Arabic and other things, so after talking to her about my background she invited me to her store to further our conversation on the Bible. It is always encouraging when you have contacts.

At another occasion it was a group of Jehovah witnesses that were giving out brochures in the street. I started a conversation and after a little while we began a study that lasted for an hour in half. Please pray for all contacts and that we will be able to reach others with the truth.

In February we had 3,673 visitors on the website from 51 countries and in March 3,961 visitors on the website from 55 countries; we are praying that some of the ones that visit there will obey the gospel.

For the last two months on Wednesday night after the class we eat together and every week someone prepares something, it is good because this way people, don't have to wait to go back home to finally eat, so in the same occasion they have the spiritual and physical food. We are studying Job.

For the Sunday morning Bible class I am almost finished with the book of Acts and afterwards Brother Stephane Dedeyan will start a class on the book of Genesis. I am continuing my Bible study with Giovally every Saturday morning, and with Franck and Liva during the week and sometime Denise and Enyo comes along with Rose and I for the study.

Several of our members have been sick, with colds, gastro(intestinal flu) and Sister Cirline Pierre who has breast cancer and had a surgery and is recuperating at home, before starting her Chemotherapy. Brother Guy Penet who has hip problems will probably have to have a hip joint surgery. He would like to get it done soon.

Like last year, I will be going to the Bible Camp in Germany from the 9th till the 16th of July. Since the up raising in the different Arab countries, gasoline right now is between \$9.13 and \$9.58 per gallon, and they announced that he will go up more in the Summer. Of course when gasoline goes up, everything else goes up with it, but like we say in France " C'est la vie". (That's Life)

We are eternally grateful unto to God , for all of you and asking His blessing upon each and every one of you for your partnership , spiritually and financially in the spreading o f the gospel in the French world.
